National Masters Meets in 1994 - The Indoor National Masters Championships will be held at Columbia State University, Outdoor Nationals will be held in Murfreesboro, Tennessee. There is a survey in the February edition of National Masters News (on page 5). For your convenience the survey has been included in this newsletter. The survey is requesting input on the scheduling of the outdoor National meets. What we would like to see changed is to suggest that the 4 X 400 meter relay be moved to day 3 following the 800 meter finals and that the 4 X 100 and 4 X 800 meter relays remain on day 4.

ACTION ITEMS: Patricia Finley will put the survey in the February newsletter.

Buffalo, Belles & Brawn - They will be hosting a meet at the bubble on February 28th. The meet will run from 9:00am to 1:00pm, doors open at 8:30am. The events include the 55M, 300M, 800M, 1600M, 55M Hurdles, Long Jump, High Jump and Shot Put. Age groups are Bantam (10 & under) through 70+. Masters groups in 10 year age increments. The cost is \$2 per event and pre-registration is not required. Ribbons are awarded for first, second and third place finishers in each age group.
