INVITATION: Athletes and coaches are invited to participate in the National USATF Masters 5 km Cross - Country Championships to be held on Sunday, November 3, 1996 at the Ohio School for the Deaf in Columbus, Ohio. This meet includes a Columbus Invitational, thus making it possible to offer Open and Masters individual and team competition.

AWARDS CEREMONIES: The Masters awards ceremony will commence at 11 am. Announcement of the Open and Submasters awards will be provided approximately 45 minutes after their events.

TEAM SCORING: Masters - aggregate (total) time of scoring members; Open and Submasters - simple scoring by position.

TEAM AWARDS: Medals to all finishing members of the top three teams; Small team trophy awarded to the top three teams

TEAM CHAMPION PATCH: awarded to all finishing members of Masters team champions

TEAM ROSTERS: Identify by 10/29/96 - register each athlete individually; submit separate list for each age - group - team on the team entry form; coach / manager's name should be given as the point - of - contact for any questions.

CANADIAN / FOREIGN ATHLETES AND TEAMS: Must be registered athletes, may compete for equivalent awards, may have names listed in results, may not displace USATF members from awards. Resident aliens (Green card holders) may compete for the US awards and must be USATF members.

ELIGIBILITY: Masters athletes must have a 1996 or 1997 USATF Card; teams must provide proof of club USATF membership prior to the race by means of a USATF Certificate or an Association letter; NCAA / NAIA university / college teams may run in the Open Division.

MEET MANAGEMENT: Reserves the right to ask for proof of age, USATF membership, and residence as specified in the USATF Rulebook. The addition of late entries to a team will require an appeal to the race referee.

EARLY PACKET PICKUP AND LATE REGISTRATION: Available in the Meet Registration Area of the Ohio School for the Deaf 4 pm until 8 pm on Saturday, Nov 2. Race schedule changes, if any, will be posted at this location.

RACE DAY REGISTRATION: opens at 7:30 a.m. and closes 30 minutes prior to each race for individual entries; each runner must wear a race number on the front and an age group designation on the front and back of the uniform top.

COURSE: single figure-8 loop on school grounds property with inspectors; mostly grass with two road crossings; mowed, coned, flagmarked with a painted line; 50 % of course is flat and 50 % is rougher, rolling grounds; spikes recommended, especially if there is rain.

FACILITIES: adequate parking (you must use the designated spaces <u>only</u>), water, restrooms, spectator viewing for 70% of the course; locker rooms with showers are available - athletes are advised to come ready to run.

DIRECTIONS: The Ohio School for the Deaf is located in north Columbus, just west of the intersection of I-71 with a main east-west thoroughfare called Morse Road. There are four motels at this intersection. It is a 600-800m walk from these motels westward to the school located at 500 Morse Road. The U Minnesota - OSU football game on November 2 will compete for the motel rooms, however there are plenty of acceptable motel rooms available on the north and east sides of the Columbus perimeter highway I-270.


