Based on Best of First Three Throws

This is our third use of these facilities, and thus a better schedule is not known to us. As we see it, we can only conduct one long throw event at a time The javelin runway and hammer/discus/weight throw cage share the same measuring field. A compact meet thus requires some sacrifice!

Two schedule categories - weight pentathletes (first) and individual events (last). All events except 56# weight - men first, oldest to youngest; then women, oldest to youngest. We will combine and compress groups where possible, special schedules are not available!


