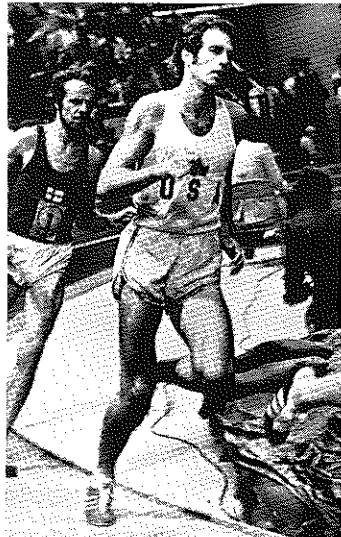

Track meets are like big Broadway musicals — there's a lot that goes on behind the scenes.

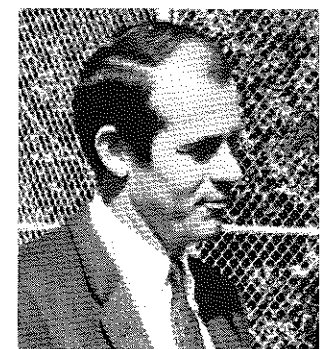
San Diego Track Club and San Diego State University have been at work on the Indoor Games for several months to make sure the curtain goes up and on an arena-full of outstanding athletes.

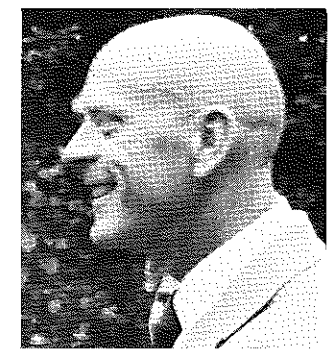

Timing at tonight's San Diego Indoor Games is by Accutrack(TM), a fully automatic photo finish and electronic timing system. The Accutrack camera is focused on the finish lane through a narrow aperture. A continuous picture of the finish line is then obtained by passing the film before the lens at approximately the same speed as the runners cross the finish. The system's electronic clock is started by an impulse from the starter's gun (note the wire leading from the gun). Electric eyes 3 feet from the finish signal the camera to start filming and the running time, to 1/100th of a second, is also recorded on the film. Then 30 seconds after completion of the race, the judges will have a photo record of the finish allowing a nearly unquestionable determination of places and times.

This device, jointly owned by San Diego Track Club and the San Diego State University, will be bringing unprecedented accuracy to the officiating of major San Diego Track & Field competitions.

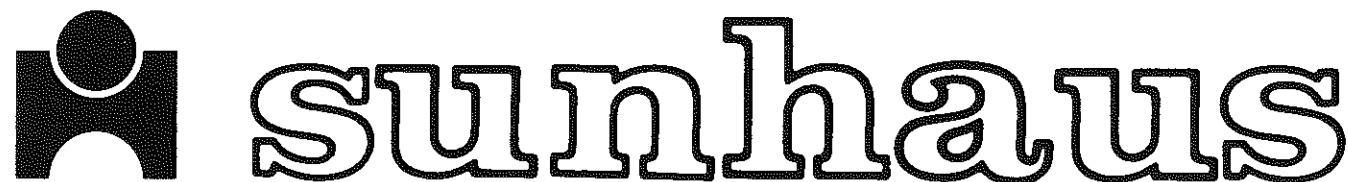

THE SAN DIEGO TRACK CLUB

Bill Gookin sat on an idea one day, and out hatched the San Diego Track Club. What popped out a dozen years ago was considerably less than what SDTC is today.

From its rag-tag beginning, SDTC has evolved into a major voice in track and field in the country. Its membership of 500 — mostly active runners of all ages — is a marvel and the envy of much older track organizations across the country which are endowed with less enthusiasm and expertise.

SDTC is a club of doers. But when Gookin, a former cross country star at San Diego State University and now a city schools teacher, joined with other founding fathers, things were much different.

Gookin would mark the course, fire the starting gun and get back first to time the others that followed.

Gookin is 1973 president of the club and there are many more things to do than ever before — but he has a lot of help these days to lend a hand.

The biggest effort of the year is the Indoor Games here tonight. But in 1972 the SDTC put on the National AAU 25 Kilometer Championship, the San Diego Relays and dozens of road races, cross country events and all-comers track meets.

SDTC nurtures talent. There is Eileen Waters, who last year became not only the first woman but the first member of SDTC to run 50 miles in a competition.

Noel Johnson is a fit 75-year-old club member. He's so fit that University of California doctors, after exhaustive testing, labled Johnson a "superman." He says running did it.

Donna Gookin, Bill's wife, holds a running and exercise class in Balboa Park under some lovely shade trees at Sixth and Laurel.

That's where Nadia Garcia, a high school student, was discovered. High schools don't offer much opportunity and encouragement to girls who want to participate in track and cross country. SDTC has filled that void in the school system and has nudged Nadia on to high laurels. She was a member of the U.S. Cross Country team at the International Championships in England and in March finished among the top eight in the 1972 AAU cross country championships.

Women — young and old and slow and fast and all with lovely figures — run in all of SDTC's track and cross country meets.

San Diego is the birthplace of the Masters (over 40) Program. SDTC put on the country's first U.S. Masters meet which was held in Balboa Stadium in 1968. There's been one every year since and the last two have been National AAU Championships. David Pain, who got the whole thing together, now has gone international and has organized a U.S. Masters team which toured Europe last summer, with New Zealand and Australia on the itinerary this year for a December round of meets.

SDTC has a team manager who gets the open athletes together — these are the younger members who aim at world records. Mike Gregorio is among the best the nation has in long distance runners. He placed 13th in the Olympic Trials Marathon. Bob Messina is so-o-o close to breaking the four-minute mile. He was clocked at 4:00.6 last season.

The once-a-month family runs bring together the wide interests of SDTC — from the sometimes jogger to the national competitors. These are fun-run type activities that are more casual and have little of the hardnosed competitiveness that marks most SDTC meets. There also is a picnic lunch.

In taking over as SDTC president for 1973, Gookin told the members in the club newsletter: "It is in the involvement of our total membership that our uniqueness, our strength and our success dwells."

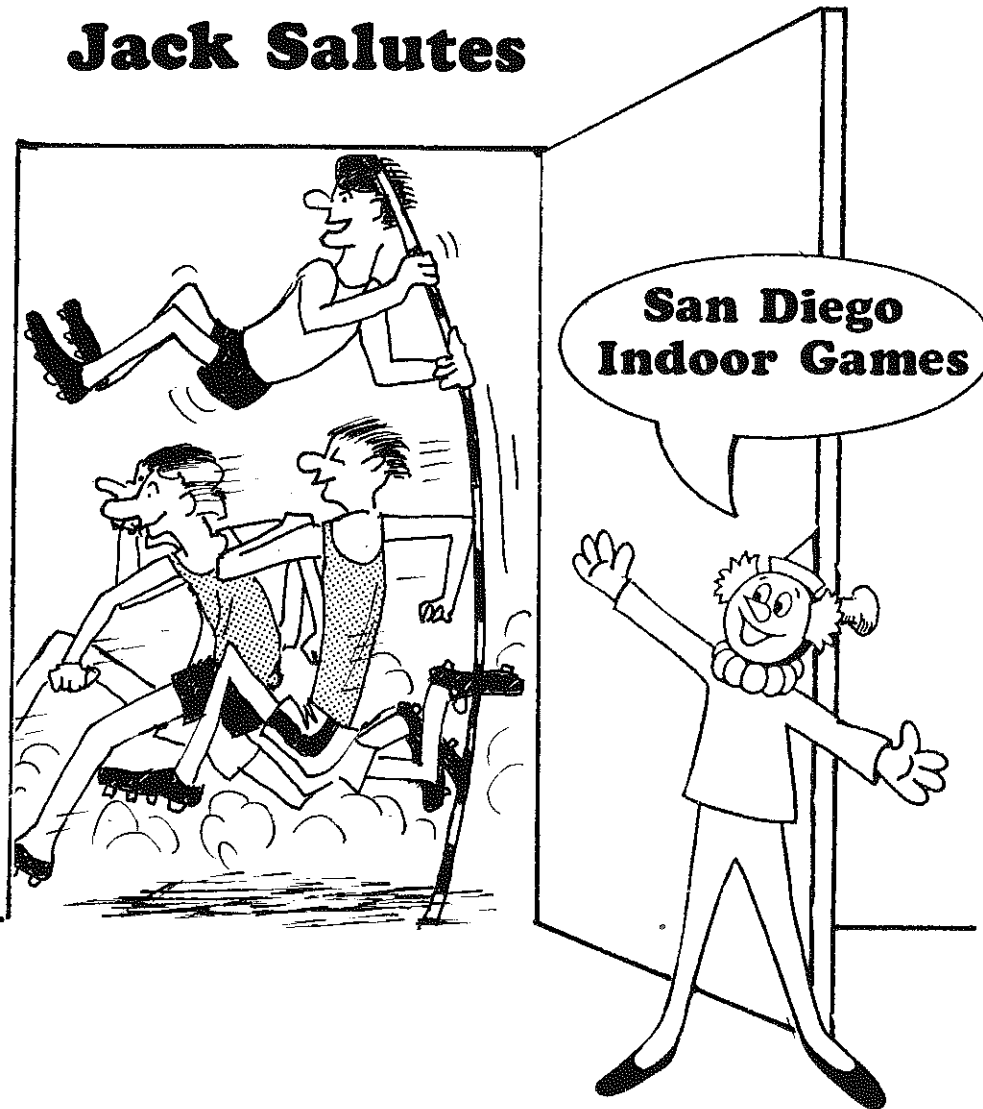

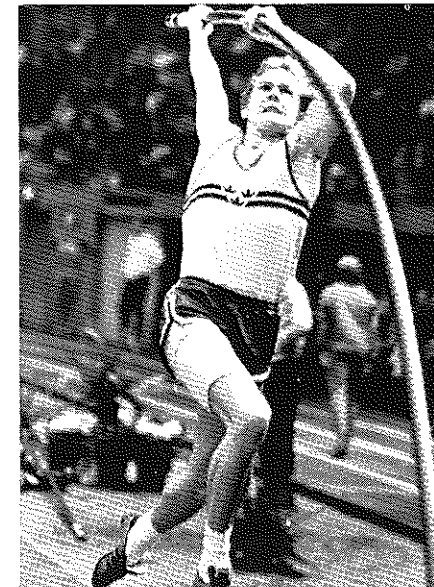

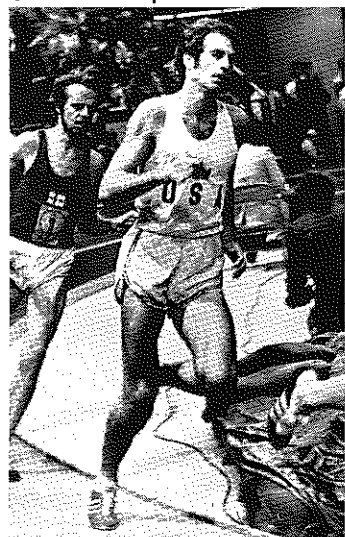

Track meets are like big Broadway musicals — there's a lot that goes on behind the scenes.

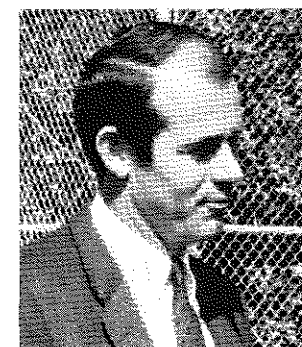
San Diego Track Club and San Diego State University have been at work on the Indoor Games for several months to make sure the curtain goes up and on an arena-full of outstanding athletes.
