ENTRY: Deadline is Thursday, December 1. Send entry blank with \$4.00 (make checks payable to Glendale Track Club) entry fee to: John Tansley, Track Coach, Glendale College, Glendale, California 91208. Check in before 8:30 a.m.; SENIORS 9:30 a.m. (OPEN), 10:30 a.m. (HS and JC). UST & FF tee shirts are available at \$4.00 in medium, large and extra large sizes.

RULES: AAU Rules pertaining to decathlon will be used. Changes: A) Masters over 50 will use 12# shot put, 3.9# (HS) discus, and run 33" hurdles; B) men over 60 will use women's shotput; discus, and javelin and run 30" hurdles; C) men over 40 will run 36" hurdles. All scoring will be done on the 1962 IAAF scoring table (current).

AWARDS: UST & FF plaques and medals to: Open-first six; High School-first five; Community Colleges-first five; Masters (30-39) first three; Masters (40-49) first three; Masters (50-54) first three; Masters (60-69) first three; Masters (70+) first two.

FACILITIES: Track-red crushed brick. Pole vault (128-6) and high jump (48-0 half fan)-Chevron 440. Long jump (150-0) run-way is Tartan. Javelin - grass, 1/4 inch spikes recommended on run-ways. We have 3 pole vault and 2 high jump pits. Showers and towels will be provided. Use your own locks or secure valuables during competition. Refreshments will be served.

PROGRAM: A program will be available at the meet. Self scoring, competitors' instructions, heat, and flight information, bar raises and miscellaneous instructions will be included.

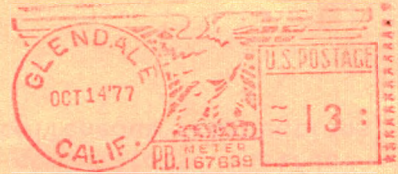

Dear Decathlete:

The Eighth Annual UST&FF Winter Decathlon was the best we've ever had. Bob Coffman, a former USC hurdler, who worked out and helped us here at Glendale College for several years, made shambles of Roger George's meet record when he strung together leading marks in six events (100m, LJ, SP, Disc, HR, 400m) to score 7,993. He had 5 PR's and upped his personal best almost 400 points. A four man 1500 produced another exciting race this year with Coffman needing a 4:36.5 to score 8000 pts. (he ran 4:37.6) and a battle between Bardales, Harvey and first time decathlete Grant Niederhaus for second through fourth. Bardales won easily (4:29.0), Niederhaus was tough, but couldn't shake Harvey for enough points to take the bronze.

Mauricio Bardales, the defending champion and 1977 NCAA Division II champion, upped his last year's total by 448 points. He must have liked GC's new pole vault pit as he upped his PR in the vault by a foot to 15'5" (4.70). Harvey also scored his best at this meet with a 7270 copped by the days best vault at 15'9" (4.80). "Believe it or not" department: Grant Niederhaus in his first ever competitive pole vault competition soared 15'5" (4.70). The Community College state champion in the intermediate hurdles and half miler at UCLA amazed everyone by scoring 7162 - his first decathlon.

Last year I predicted Bardales would win the NCAAII. How about these: Coffman in the top 5 in the world in '78 and the Olympic Team in '80. Bardales to be really pushed in the NCAA Division I but winning. Niederhaus as PAC 8 champion and Harvey to just keep getting better and putting distance on the total points and number of decathlons.

In other divisions the competition was equally fierce. Even though Glendale College holds more State Decathlon records than any other JC, no Glendale College athlete has won this meet. Jan Bear, a sophomore at Glendale College, upped his PR to 6544 to win easily and qualify for the 1978 California State meet along with Rich Hohlman of Pierce (6166).

Chris Doble (Troy HS) won the high school division with a meet record 6,030 points. This erased Gary Bruner's (Indio) record of 5907. Gary, a promising young decathlete, had a knee operation for severely torn ligaments suffered in football this fall. Tohru Asami (Sunny Hills), who was 7th last year, looked like the winner until he no-heighted the pole vault, but still hung on for 3rd with 5622. It was a better pill for the tiny Asami who long jumped 22'8 1/2" and high jumped 6'7".

In the submasters 30-39 group, Dennis Stempel defended his last year's title but failed to break his own record of 5987. The 40-49 was won by veteran Harry Hawke of San Diego (4737) and Bob Hunt (3474) held off "Doc" Parkinson (3136) of Indio for the gold in the 50-59 division. Jim Vernon cleared 11'6" with his "funny" pole to win the 60-69 division with 3164 points. Redmond Doms, the oldest decathlete at 70 years, scored 1474 points, erasing Stan Herrmann's record.

We probably put on more track events at Glendale College than any institution in Southern California. The decathlon is the toughest, but we have always had great cooperation from the decathletes.

Next year's "bash" will be on December 4-5, I hope you'll be back. Congratulations to all of you that completed the decathlon. Have a great 1978. Merry Christmas and Happy New Year.

# Bear wins at GC

Bob Coffman of the Houston Track Club set a meet record of 7,993 points in winning the open division of the UST&FF Decathlon Sunday at Glendale College. Jan Bear of Glendale College won the JC division with 6,544 points, just missing the Vaquero school record by six points. Carlos Garcia accumulated 6,550 when he won the State meet in 1973.

The open record was 7,585 set by Roger George in 1973. This was the eighth annual event hosted by GC track coach John Tansley and 102 athletes competed.

Coffman's marks were 10.8 in the 100 meters, 23-1 1/2 in the long jump, 49-9 shot put, 6-3 1/4 high jump, 48.4 400 meters, 14.4 110 hurdles, 157-9 discus, 14-1 1/4 pole vault, 177-7 javelin and 4:37.6 1,500 meters.

Defending champion Mauricio Bardales of UC Irvine was second in the open division with 7,641 points and Rex Harvey of the U.S. Air Force, the '74 and '75 winner, was third with 7,270 points.

Grant Niederhaus of Macabiah TC and UCLA, making his first appearance in the decathlon was fourth with 7,162 points, clearing 15-1 1/4 on his first ever competitive pole vault.

Tom Bryon and Dennis Morley, both of Fresno State, were fifth and sixth with 6,765 and 6,680 points.

Rich Hohlmann of Pierce was the JC runner-up with 6,166, followed by Doug Nordquist of Fullerton with 5,411 points.

Competing in the event for the fourth year, Chris Doble of Troy High won the prep division with 6,630 points. Bob White of La Canada was fourth with 5,475.

Tony Snake of Toll and Robert Pote of Toll were 1-2 in the junior high division with 4,065 and 1,839.
