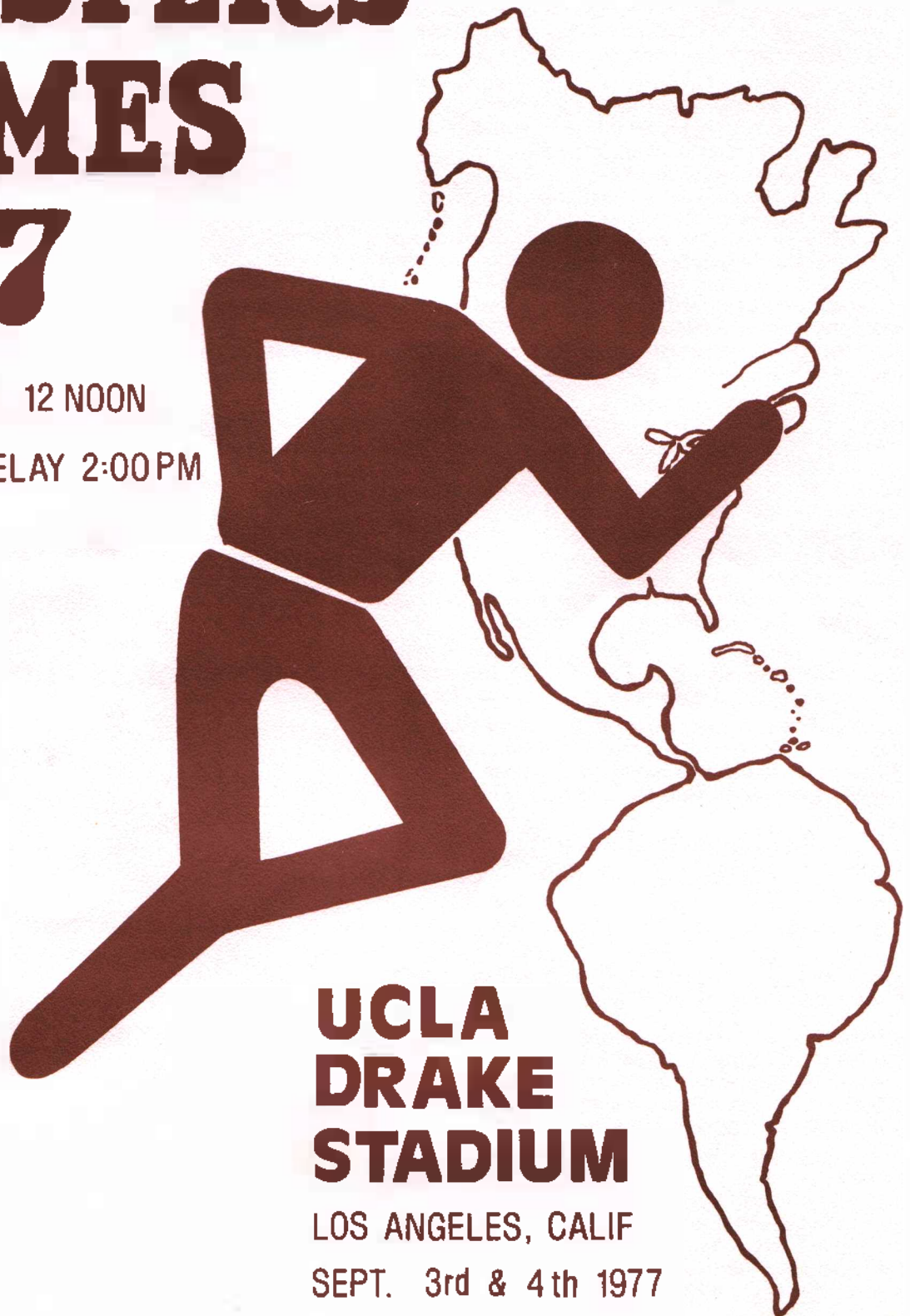

# WELCOME

# SO. CALIFORNIA STRIDERS (cont.)

It gives me great pleasure to welcome you to the first Pan American Masters Games, a track & field meet that is being hosted by the Southern California Striders. Today you will have an opportunity to see some truly fine senior athletes in action from 17 states and 9 foreign countries that include Canada, Mexico, Trinidad-Tobago, Puerto Rico, Venezuela, Colombia, Guyana, Australia and South Africa. These athletes will be competing in five year age divisions, running distances of 100 to 10,000 meters and participating in all field events from the hammer throw to the pole vault.

Running for fitness and fun became competitive running for senior runners in the late 1960's. Just as young age groupers had track & field meets, Master and Sub-Master athletes, age thirty through eighty began to have their own track & field season, with a championship meet and the recording of age group records. This made running as exciting at age fifty as it was at age twenty. Today you will also be witnessing a sport whose time has come of age. Many of the athletes competing here have just returned from the World Masters Games in Sweden where over 2,500 senior athletes from 35 countries of the world met in an international track & field meet to not only determine the worlds best, but to perpetuate brotherhood and good will among their fellow men and women.

Senior runners are men and women who refuse to let time and age stop them from being participants in the game of life. As Doctor George Sheehan, a 58 year old runner stated, "Like all runners, I live in the present. I am not interested in the way we were. The past is already incorporated in me. There is no use returning to it. I live for today. Running gives me self-expression, a way of finding out who I am and who I will be. It makes me intimate with pain. I have always within reach, the opportunity to test my absolute barriers, to search out the borders set up by straining muscles and a failing brain."

Because he refuses to look back, the runner remains ageless. That is his secret, that through an obedience to running he maintains a never ending compulsion for life.

To spectators and visiting athletes from other states and countries, I thank you for sharing this day with us here in California, and I sincerely hope that you can be with us for the next Pan American Masters Games in 1978.

## SO. CALIFORNIA STRIDERS

The Masters program officially became a division of the SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA STRIDERS created by a vote of the Board members on February 19, 1970. TOBY J. MEDINA was elected a Board member and placed in sole charge of the senior Strider program.

From a beginning at the San Diego Invitational Track and Field Meet on June 11, 1966, where 12 Master milers dueled before 10,000 fans, (our own TOBY MEDINA competed for the Los Angeles Police Department), to our complete program today, where we have about 95 men and women members running, walking, jumping and throwing — we have come a long way.

The SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA STRIDERS are primarily a track and field club whose members compete in age group competition, although we are not limited to track and field or age group, under our by-laws. The club is a non-profit organization, it is non-sectarian, interracial and devoted to the idea of benefitting the youth and adults of Southern California through recreation and competition, emphasizing track and field. Our members are expected, on occasion, to take part in such things as youth rallies, athletic clinics and, in general, to promote the work of the STRIDERS in Southern California. We have a year-around program with the emphasis on track and field during the months of May through August.

Each year, in January, we all gather in Palm Desert, near Palm Springs, for a fun meet to start our running year. We end the season for those who wish, with a weightman Pentathlon and a Decathlon at Glendale College, in late December. We have walks, marathons, road races, long distance runs, jog-a-thons and track and field meets all during the year.

The Strider membership roster contains people of all ages and backgrounds whose common interest is running and field event competition. We have ex-world class competitors in the club such as Pary O'Brien, Walt Butler and John Dobroth, as well as members who have never competed at all until their fortieth birthday. Members receive a monthly newsletter with its schedule of events, results of competition and articles of interest.
