Deadline is Wednesday, December 8. Send blank entry with \$4.00 entry fee to: John Tansley, Track Coach, Glendale College, Glendale California 91208. Check in before 8:30 a.m. (MASTERS), 9:30 a.m. (OPEN), 10:30 a.m. (HS and JC). UST & FF tee shirts are available at \$3.00 in medium, large and extra large sizes.

RULES:

AAU Rules pertaining to decathlon will be used. Changes:  
A) masters over 40 will run 36" hurdles, B) masters over 50 will use 12# shot put, 3.9# (HS) discus, and run 36" hurdles,  
C) men over 60 will use womens shotput; discus, and javelin and run 30" hurdles. All scoring will be done on the 1962 IAAF scoring table (current).

AWARDS:

UST & FF plaques and medals to: Open-first six; High School-first three; Community Colleges-first three; Masters (30-39) first three; Masters (40-49) first three; Masters (50-54) first three; Masters (60 and over) first three; Masters 70 and over first three. Special awards for age group records.

FACILITIES:

Track-red crushed brick. Pole vault (128-6) and high jump (48-0 half fan)-Chevron 440. Long jump (150-0) runaway is tartan. Javelin-grass,  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch spikes recommended on runaways. We will have 3 pole vault and 2 high jump pits this year. Showers and towels will be provided. Use your own locks or secure valuables during competition. Refreshments will be served.

PROGRAM:

A program will be available at the meet. Competitors instructions, heat, and flight information, bar raises and miscellaneous instructions will be included.

## GLENDALE COLLEGE

December 26, 1976

Dear Decathlete,

Congratulations on being part of the "World's Largest Decathlon Meet." Only one in every 1.5 million people have ever finished a decathlon. We had 113 competitors this year and 90 finished all ten events. The logistics of staging this meet is awesome but the real credit goes to you competitors who did a great job of competing scoring and hustling. To you lucky ones who "split" before darkness we finished the last three pole vaulters with car lights and the 1500 in complete darkness (a true Hollywood finish).

New records were set by Gary Bruner of Indio High School in the high school division with 5,901 points. Gary finished 8th last year with 4147. Dennis Stempel of the Bay Area Striders shattered John Dobroth's 30-39 record with 5,991. Rex Harvey competed in his 59th decathlon and 11th this year, both world records. Chet McGaugh has never missed this meet (seven straight, seventh this year).

Mauricio Bardales of UC Irvine won the "Seventh Annual" closing fast to edge Rex Harvey in the last three events. Bardales has to be one of the top collegiate decathletes in the USA and should be favored to win the NCAA this year. Mauricio attended Murphy High School here in Los Angeles.

This was the largest high school field we have ever had (31). Every attempt is being made to match up American and World records for age groups young and old.. Tony Snake set an American 14 year old record and the Masters group set more records than we could list. Buell Crane is 76 years old and Tony is 14, a difference of 62 years.

Despite the mysterious loss of the entries this year, the meet went well. We hope to have a new pole vault pit next year and an additional runway that will give us two long jumps and three pole vault pits. Most of the judges were Glendale College track athletes. I still have a few "T" shirts available if you want one... they're nice looking (\$3.50).

I hope you'll be back next year for the annual "bash". Put this date on your new calendar ... December 10-11, 1977, UST&FF Winter Decathlon, Glendale College. My typist went blind, my wife thinks I'm nuts and I slept 14 hours straight Sunday night but... let's do it again.

## Record Number in Decathlon

In the largest decathlon ever held Mauricio Bardales won the open division edging Rex Harvey Saturday and Sunday at Glendale College.

According to meet director John Tansley there were 107 competitors, breaking the record set last year at Glendale.

Bardales from University of California at Irvine was trailing Harvey

going in to the last event the 1500 meter run, and came on strong to win the race and win with 7193 points. Harvey representing the U.S. Air Force had 7176 points.

Third place finisher in the open division was Dennis Morley from Fresno State.

In the community college division Brian Saunders of De Anza College was first

with Arlen West from El Camino College second and Tom Turner from Fullerton College third. The top local competitor was Steve Toth of Glendale College in 11th.

In the high school division which had the most entrants with 39 Gary Bruner of Indio took first scoring 5907 points to establish a meet record. Second place finisher Chris

Dobie, also eclipsed the old mark with 5817 points.

Dave Tolson of Verdugo Hills High School finished third with 5731 points.

In the masters divisions Dennis Stempel from Bay Area Striders took the 35-39 grouping with 5991 points and set a new meet record.

Harry Hawk of the San Diego Track Club took the 40-49 bracket with 4745 points. Bob Hunt of the Striders won the 50-59 age group with 3335 points. Stan Thompson of the Hawaiian Masters Track Club took the 60-69 group with 1516 points.

There also were two competitors in the 70 and over bracket. Stan Herrmann from Club West won first with 1160 edging Buell Crane from Idaho Falls, Idaho who had 1129 points. Crane is a spry 76 years old.

Dave Yost turned in the top time in the 100 meters at 10.9. In the long jump high schooler Tahir Asami went 21 feet 7 for the top mark. Harvey had the best mark in the shot put with 44 feet 8 and the pole vault at 15 feet 5 1/4.

Bardales recorded the best marks in the 400 and 1500 meter runs with 49.1 and 4:23.1 respectively. Bill Sanchez had the best time in the 120 yard high hurdles at 15.3. Jim Anthony recorded the top marks in the discus and javelin with 149 feet 11 and 150 feet 5 1/4 respectively.

## Decathletes range from 14 to 76 years

They came in all ages and from all directions to compete in last weekend's U.S. Track and Field Federation decathlon meet at Glendale College.

The oldest was Buell Crane, 76, who arrived by bus from Idaho Falls, Idaho.

The youngest was 14-year-old Tony Snake of Toll Junior High student who could have easily trashed his skateboard, since he lives less than five miles from the Vaquero campus.

They were only two of 107 entries who combined to produce the largest decathlon field in history.

And when the two-day competition ended, Glendale's Snake wound up with two records, while Crane settled for a second place finish in their respective age-group divisions.

The Toll student produced an American age-group record (14-and-under) of 3,520 points and a world age-group mark for decathlon javelin performance — getting off a toss of 117-10.

Buell totaled 1,129 points in a runner-up finish behind 73-year-old Stan Herrmann (1,160) of Club West Santa Barbara in the 70-and-over division.

Mario Bardales, a UC Irvine student and former prep at North Hollywood High, won the open division in a thrilling finish, coming from behind to score a last event win in the 1,500 meters over open runnerup Rex Harvey of the Air Force.

Harvey, who produced the meet's top marks in the shot put (13.50 meters), pole vault (4.70 meters) and 100 meters

(11.1 seconds) stayed close to Bardales for most of the final race before the Irvine runner pulled away to win by approximately 60 yards with a 4:23 clocking.


That win gave Bardales a first place total of 7,193 points, while Harvey placed second at 7,176. Dennis Morley, who had the meet's top mark in the high jump at 1.95 meters, finished third in open division at 6,621 points.

Other top marks included a 49.1 time in the 400 meters by Bardales; a 15.1 clocking in the 120-meter high hurdles by Michael Grein (Las Vegas); a 6.56-meter long jump by Joe Hippenstein of Fresno State; and a double by unattached Jim Anthony in the discus (45.72 meters) and javelin (64.52 meters).

Other divisional winners included Brian Saunders of DeAnza in JC (6,377); Gary Bruner of Indio High in high school (5,907); Dennis Stempel of Bay Area Striders in Masters 30-39 (5,991); Harry Hawke of San Diego TC in Masters 40-49 (4,945); Bob Hunt of Tobias Striders in Masters 50-59 (3,335); Stan Thompson of Hawaiian Masters in Masters 60-69 (1,516); and Herrman in Masters 70-plus at 1,160.

David Tolson of Verdugo Hills High placed third in the high school division with 5,731 points.

Toll's Snake, former Burroughs star Jan Bear (now at Glendale College) and GC track coach John Tansley will all compete in the Santa Maria decathlon Dec. 30-31, when Snake will attempt to improve on his age-group 14-and-under records (he turns 15 in January).
