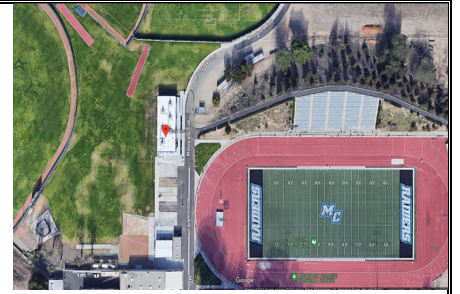

Moorpark College, Moorpark

- SITE & SPIKES:** Griffin Stadium, Moorpark College in Moorpark, a nine-lane Beynon track with excellent throwing and jumping facilities. Spikes must be pyramid or needle, 3/16-inch or shorter (high jump and javelin ¼-inch or shorter).
- TIMING:** Fully automatic timing by Speed Timing.
- ENTRY FEE:** \$35.00 for first event. \$10.00 for second event. \$5.00 for each additional event.
- USATF MEMBERSHIP:** U.S. competitors and resident aliens must be 2024 members of USA Track & Field. A current 2024 membership number will be required to submit an online meet entry. Athletes can join/renew their members at <https://www.usatf.org/home-normal/top-utility-nav-content/membership/individual-adult-membership> (see “Join Today” button at bottom of that page).
If you are an international athlete without a green card or an F-1 visa, and you compete for another country, you do not need USATF membership; contact Eric Barron at ericbarron@roadrunner.com.
- ENTRY PROCEDURE & DEADLINE:** Entries for Open athletes must be made on-line at <https://www.scausatf.org/sports/track-field/jim-bush>
Entries for Masters athletes must be made on-line at <https://www.scausatf.org/sports/track-field/masters-tf/> by 11:59 p.m. PDT on Thursday, June 6. Athletes must be entered as “unattached” if they are not members of a USATF-registered club. Meet entries will be posted here <https://www.simplyregister.net/status/?e=125963> and updated hourly as received.
Events with fewer than four competitors will unlikely be contested.
- ATHLETE CHECK-IN:** **RUNNING EVENTS:** 45-minutes prior to the scheduled start of each running event, competitors must check in at the **CLERK’S TENT**—after which those who have not checked in will be scratched. 20 minutes prior to each running event, runners must return to the Clerk to pick up their hip numbers and heat assignments.
FIELD EVENTS: 45 minutes prior to the event, competitors must check in with the Head Judge.
- IMPLEMENT WEIGH-IN:** Throwing implements will be certified near the old field house on the north side of the track.
- PARKING & ADMISSION:** Parking is free and available in Lots 1, 3, 4, and 6. A school map is at www.moorparkcollege.edu/campus-map. Spectator admission is only \$5 (kids 10 and under are free).
- RESULTS:** Copies of results will be available at www.scausatf.org and www.moorparktrack.com.

The Southern California USATF Championship celebrates the extraordinary coaching career of Jim Bush. Jim’s success as a Southern California high school, junior college, and university coach is without peers. Fullerton High School, Kern County, CA, Bakersfield College, Occidental College, UCLA, the U.S. Track Coaches Association, and USA Track & Field have all inducted Jim into their Hall-of-Fame. Jim coached 118 NCAA medalists and 30 Olympians. He had been a coach for three USA teams in international competitions. Jim spent 53 years coaching several generations of America’s Olympic hopefuls. No one is more deserving of having a track meet bearing his name and for that meet to be a worthy legacy.
