Dear Monty:

Following up on our faxes of yesterday, here are the accounting details re the remaining bills.

Per Torsten's instructions to me on October 4 and subsequent correspondence with you, I have:

- 1) Expensed on WAVA's 1996-97 books:
 - a. US\$2059 for flags (R9621.60 per my fax to you of October 6).
 - b. US\$5379 for drug tests (R25,137 per " " "
- 2) Written a check to National Masters News for US\$1176.
- 3) Created an "accounts payable" ledger for the difference.

Thus, WAVA now owes the Durban OC (payable to you or whomever you designate) a total of US\$6262. The understanding, as you reconfirmed in your fax yesterday, is for you to meet the costs for the printing and distribution of the results books, and also the copying and distribution of the videos.

Over the next 10 days, I plan to transfer all of WAVA's funds (approximately US\$200,000) to WAVA's new account in Switzerland, under the direction of the new WAVA Treasurer, Peppo Galfetti.

Thus, when you are ready to ask Peppo for the funds, you will know that you have \$US6262 available to you.

I am copying Peppo and Torsten with this fax. I will prepare the final 1996-97 accounting statement within the next two weeks. Meanwhile, Peppo can count on about US\$200,000 being transferred into the new account.



Dear Monty:

This is a follow-up to my fax of October 2.

1. Torsten called me Saturday morning (at about 5 a.m., my time, so I wasn't fully awake) and asked me to send a check, made out to you, for:

- a. The Flag bill (about US\$2059) -- R9621.60
- b. Drug testing (about US\$5379) -- R25,137.00
- c. Less US\$1176 for NMN

That's a total of about US\$6262.

He said you would pay the flag and drug people at your own discretion, leaving adequate funds to print the results book and mail it to the athletes.

He implied that if you didn't get these funds, made out to you, that the results book would not be printed.

As I say, I was only half-awake, so please correct me if I'm wrong. (I may call him to confirm all this, but I wanted to contact you, first.)

Is all the above okay with you?

2. If okay, I can either:

- a. Send you a check, as before, for the amount, in USD.
- b. Wire transfer the funds (in USD) to your account.

My bank used to be unable to do the latter, but now they can. However, they cannot issue an international draft, nor can they wire funds in Rand. It must be in U.S. dollars.

Please let me know what you prefer.

3. However, while I'm officially no longer Treasurer, I still have control of the books (Peppo has not yet opened a bank account, but he's working on it). I feel a certain responsibility not to spend money frivolously. To wit, were any drug tests actually done? If so, what were the results?

Hannelore told me she and Cesar, as members of the WAVA Doping Committee, went several times to the place where the drug testing was supposed to be held. But "the place was always closed," she told me. She was told "there is no drug testing today."

So I think before I send the funds we should know if testing was done and what the results were.

Thank you for your fax of Sept. 26 re the bills for flags and drug testing.

1. Do you know who in WAVA handled the flag deal? I show nothing in the WAVA budget for such an expenditure. Let me know, if you know, so I can contact him or her for details.
2. I notice there was nothing on the drug testing invoice to indicate how many tests were performed or what the results of those tests were. Again, do you know who in WAVA was involved in this? There was never any discussion of drug testing in any of the Council meetings. One Dr. Alonso is head of WAVA's Doping Committee, but I don't know if he was even in Durban. If you know, let me know. We do have US\$5000 budgeted for drug testing for 1996-97, but it seems to me we should have the results of the tests before we pay the bill.
3. Unless I hear from you otherwise, I will assume the Durban Council is not paying the bills of the OC. Thus, I will try to get others on the WAVA Council to agree with you that the NMN bill should be paid by WAVA and deducted from the flag and/or drug testing bills.

Dear Al

I am faxing to you herewith copies of two invoices which Linda ~~the~~ Barron informs me are to be included in your WAVA financials covering the recent world championships. These invoices are as follows:

1. an invoice from Flag and Banner for R9 621,60 being in respect of four standard (1.8m x 1.2m) flags and two large (3m x 1.75m) flags. As you will see from the invoice, the cost of the standard flags is R3 237,60 and the cost of the large flags is R6 384,00 (both inclusive of VAT);
2. an invoice from the University of the Orange Free State in respect of their drug testing charges totalling the sum of R25 137,00 (inclusive of VAT).

With regard to the final accounts for the recent WAVA championships, the position is, as I reported to you telephonically earlier this week, that pressure is being brought upon the Durban City Council by the creditors to pay all creditors' claims. Present indications are that the council is reviewing its decision not to pay and although a final reversal of this decision has not yet been made, I am informed that the likelihood is that the council will either pay all claims or alternatively will make a substantial contribution towards these claims.

You will no doubt be in a position to take care of the N.M.N claim out of the refunds due by WAVA in respect of the enclosed invoices.

I will again communicate with you once a final decision by the council will have been made known to me. In the meantime, I wish you well and ask you to convey my good wishes to Helen, David and Linda.

I received page 2 of your fax to David Pain, along with a note to me at the bottom. If you sent anything else, I did not receive it.

I would like to include some details about the Durban City Council decision not to pay its bills in the October issue of NMN. However, we are printing on Mon. Sept. 22. I don't feel I have enough info to write anything now. Could you fill me in a little?

As you are well aware, Durban has come and gone. However, the nightmare lingers on because of the administrative blunders which occurred mainly as a result of the provincialism which prevailed in the attitudes of my Durban organising committee. Unfortunately their self deception in believing that they could handle all matters without outside help and experience quickly backfired on them and it took fully two or three days before any semblance of order had been restored in the areas of declarations and heat draws. In fact the very people who were responsible for these fiascos were the people who vetoed my proposal that we take advantage of yours and Linda's very kind offer of assistance.

To make matters worse, the employees of the Durban City Council who sat on the Organizing Committee and assured us of the availability of the Council's underwriting funding for the event have now been unable to secure for us payment of the balance of the funding due from the Council and we are now awaiting a decision from the Council as to whether it will or will not meet the Organizing Committee's outstanding obligations to creditors. A very sad state of affairs because if the Council refuses to pay, a number of these creditors may well end up bankrupt whilst others who can afford to take the loss find themselves in a catch 22 position because of not wishing to upset the present business relationships which they have with the Council and which they hope will be ongoing.

Al will no doubt be in a position to give you a pretty good insight into what went wrong as well as the causes for it as I understand that he will be seeing you shortly.

Enough of my complaints. How about you? I do hope that you and Linda are both well and that particularly Helen's health has stabilised. Leone and I are both thinking of you and wish you well.
