RAIMO PIHL, (Pihl is a 21-year-old freshman at Brigham Young who was born in Finland and moved to Sweden when he was one.)

"I'm happy to have won here and at Texas, but I'm not too happy with my results. I should have thrown 270. I threw 265 in practice the day before yesterday. My form just wasn't so good today."

"I hope to get 280 by the end of the year." (Best Javelin Throw Friday--255-3)

HOUSTON'S 4-MILE RELAY TEAM, Leonard Hilton: "This was a personal best for me by one-tenth of a second. I was trying to run 3:57 but I slowed down a little on the last lap. I wasn't really tired. I just felt all alone out there."

Eric Sigmont: "I knew we were close to the record but I was getting too tired at the end. I was going for it (the record) but I felt weak and sore. I just didn't have it."

FRANK SHORTER, (Florida Track Club, winner three-mile run).

"If it hadn't been windy I could have had 13. The wind was worth six or seven seconds. I've been training through this meet. I ran 15 miles yesterday and I'll run 15 today. I want to key on the AAU. Duncan (announcer Jim) helps you a lot when he calls off the times. It makes you push a little harder at the end of each lap. When he announces the record pace, you go for it instead of slouching off."

BRIGHAM YOUNG'S RALPH MANN (winner of 440-yard hurdles).

"I had a little trouble because I over-ran my hurdles. I lost one second on the tenth hurdle because of that. It's the same thing that happened to me at Texas. I was too close to the hurdles. This is my favorite track in the whole world."

DALLAS BAPTIST, Two-Mile Relay:

JOHNNY CHRISTIAN: "We're satisfied because we won but we have done better individually. We just put enough together to win."

JIMMY EVANS: (ran the anchor) "We can do better. We've run way better before. I always think I can do better than what I did. But I am happy that we won. It's always a big thrill to win here."

JOHN MC QUIRE of Abilene Christian's 880-yard relay team: "It was the most satisfying win for us so far. Any time you beat Texas A&M, you know you've done something. This is the first time out for us because one of our guys was hurt at the Texas Relays."

MIKE BURNS, Special High Jump: "I came out here hoping for 7-2 and I'm not really happy with my height. But I feel good about winning. This is the fourth time I've been out here and the first time I've won. I didn't feel much pressure jumping against Wanamaker and Fosbury because I beat both of them before. I try not to let the pressure bother me. I just concentrate on jumping. This was my second 7 foot jump in a row." (26 year old school teacher from Michigan -- took day off to come out here).

GREG JOHNSON, Long Jump: "This was my first meet since the NCAA but I felt pretty good. I was trying for 26 on that last jump but I got too much speed and got my trail leg in front of my jump leg. As a result, I left the board flat footed and jumped only about 22. I feel 26 feet is coming. I did 26-1 here last year but I scratched by a fraction of an inch. So I think I'll get it soon."

#### SATURDAY'S QUOTES

FRANK SHORTER (Six-Mile Run) "I didn't want to kick it too far because my legs were getting tight. I didn't want them to knot up so I saved it for the last turn. I pulled ahead to see what Gary (Bjourkland) would do but I got tired so I dropped back. I told you Gary was really good. He scares me, especially when he's fresh. No collegiate will beat him this year. When you run the six-mile, it takes a week or two to think about running it again. It really takes it out of you. The three is different, I could run that every weekend."

JACQUES ACCAMBRAY (Kent State--hammer throw), "I was upset with my distance. I had been practicing with my hammer for two weeks just for the Drake Relays and then I broke it in practice yesterday. I had to use another and it threw me off." Accambray is 21 years old and from Bruay en Artois, France.

RODNEY MILBURN (Southern, 120-yard high hurdles winner), "I'm not dissatisfied with my time but I think I can get :13.2. That's what I was shooting for today. If I wouldn't have hit those two hurdles, I might have gotten it. I caused the false start. I came out first so I could try my leg muscle. I came out fast and eased up before the first hurdle. If I get over my leg injuries, I think I could get below :13.2."

JEROME HOWE (Kansas State distance medley relay team), "I felt great today. It was the best I've ever felt going into the last lap. I positioned myself well today. It was my first race against LaBadie (Lee, who ran the Illinois anchor), but I knew he had a lot of speed. I was expecting quite a bit from him. I would rather have him run ahead like he was. It's easier for me to follow a fast pace then to set one. This was my best time ever at the Relays, but my coach clocked me at 3:59.9 at Texas." Howe's father runs a 134-acre farm near Treynor, Iowa.

GORDON HINTY (anchor, Eastern Michigan distance medley relay team), "This was my best race ever. My teammates ran real well and that helped a lot. I went out really fast and ran hard the last two laps. It was easy after that. This was my best time for the mile. My best before was 4:08.9. Seiler is the guy who won it for us. He got us off to a good start."

WAYNE SEILER (Eastern Michigan distance medley relay team, ran the first leg), "The main thing today was to get off fast and that's what I was able to do."

MEL GRAY (Missouri, 100-yard dash), "I was having some hamstring problems in the indoor season and I'm still not completely over them. Herb Washington (of Michigan State, who finished third) pressed me more than I figured. He's usually the strongest in the first 60 yards, but he was strong all the way today. I was pretty nervous about that. False starts always make you tense. It bugs me. They tense everybody up. I was pleased with my time. I'm pleased whenever I win. I hate the pressure, but I like to win."

MIKE MILIER (Indiana's 440-yard university relay team), --ran second leg-- "My groin felt really bad. It's taped from my thigh up to my stomach. Coach called me this morning and told me I wasn't going to run, but I told him I had to."

GARY POWELL (Indiana's 440-yard university relay team), --ran third leg-- "We all had good splits and our handoffs went exceptionally well. We work hard on those and we were happy to see them go off so well today."

WILLIE POLK (Texas Southern, 440-yard relay college winner) --ran second leg-- "We were going for 39 today, but we're happy to have gotten what we did (40.0). We ran 39.9 earlier this year but we had a new anchor man then. Our regular anchor man was out for a month. We're starting to get stronger with him back in there. We're shooting for :39.0 by the end of the season."

#### SATURDAY QUOTES CONTINUED

GREG CARLBERG (mile run), "I felt real strong at the end. In fact it was the strongest I've ever felt at the end. I seemed to be able to double back pretty well. I know I would have gone faster if the pace had been faster but I just adjusted to the pace today and I'm really happy to have won. Normally, if I'm fresh I have to set the pace because I'm not normally a strong finisher."

ROGER COLGLAZIER (Abilene Christian), "This was a great weekend for Abilene Christian. The same guys won the 880-relay and the mile relay and we're all really happy. We had a meet Tuesday so we used it as a workout for the Relays. It helped because it got us ready. I really had to put it on there at the end. It scared me when I saw a shadow and didn't know who it was so I turned it on. Our time today of 3:05.6 makes our school record of 3:06.6. My anchor today was a little slower than my best at the Drake Relays. I did :45.3 here a year ago.

PAT MATZDORF (high jump winner), "I wanted to concentrate on coming in faster and I think I was able to do it. Usually I don't build up that much speed but I felt I needed the extra speed today. I had a great lift on my second jump but my leg gave way on me and I couldn't get enough forward motion. I haven't jumped since the NCAA indoor meet. This was my best outdoor jump. I went 7-2 3/4 indoors once."

TOM GEREDINE (Northeast Missouri - triple jump), "I was fairly pleased with what I did today but my rhythum was not as good as it should be. I bruised my heal earlier this year and I'm just coming off it now. I'm getting stronger though, and I feel I'm getting better as the season progresses. You get tight on an event like this because you have to wait so long between jumps. I just try to stay relaxed. I sit down and make sure I keep stretching."

DAVE ROBERTS (Rice, Pole Vault), "I was sliding off to the side and this is what affected my jumping. The coach told me to come in harder and keep my feet up. I came in hard enough but I didn't keep my feet up. If I had kept my feet up, I could have made that last jump." Dave Roberts is a 19 year old sophomore from Rice.

TOM CRAIG (Oklahoma, Pole Vault), "I was coming out too soon. I made every one of my jumps on the third try. What really psyched me up was when the other events were over, the people crowded around the polevault area and this really fired me up." Tom Craig is also a sophomore.
