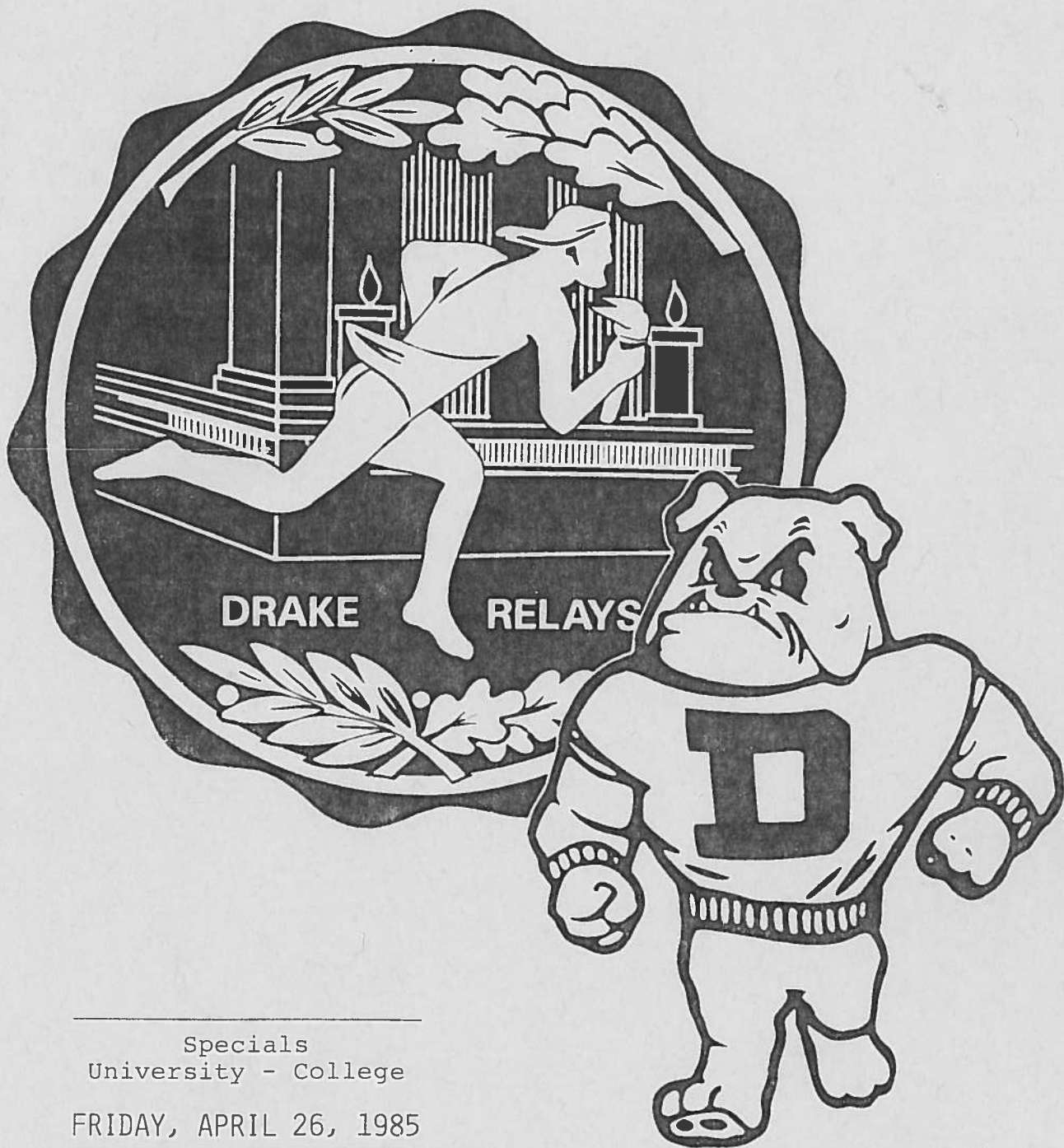

### Matt Zuber, Iowa Valley of Marengo, Winner Boys HS 110-High Hurdles in 14.70

I thought the race would go faster. I ran a 14.32 last summer and I've run better this year. My blocks have been improving, it's the last five hurdles I need to work on.

I'm trying to figure out where I'm going to school right now. It's between Texas A&M and Iowa State.

### Gwen Torrence, Georgia - Winner Women's Invitational 100-Meter Dash in 11.53

Two weeks ago, I got a cramp at the Dogwood Relays. This was my first race since then so I was kind of scared. While I got into the blocks they slipped and I felt my leg tighten, but when I started to run, it felt okay. I felt myself running a little wild. I had problems with my arm action.

I'm a sophomore, so I hope I can win this race four years in a row. I wouldn't mind at all.

### Greg Love, Illinois State - Anchor on Illinois State's winning 4 x 1600 Relay, 16:19.14, 3:57.9 split.

To tell you the truth, last year was quite a bit easier. My split was only a 4:06 and this year I had to go 3:57 plus. We repeated as champs (4-mile relay) at the Dogwood Relays and at the Kansas Relays earlier so we really wanted this race. I was a little surprised since my previous best was a 4:03 split. My best open mile was a 4:04. That's my usual race tactic to make my move with about 500 meters to go.

### Jan Chesbro, Unattached - Winner Women's Invitational High Jump at 6-3 - DRAKE RELAYS RECORD

I didn't jump indoors this year and I didn't start working out until February. I think the weather was perfect today. It wasn't too hot and it wasn't too windy. This was my personal record and it felt very good.

I went to Texas Tech and worked as a graduate assistant track coach. I saw the women jumping and I said 'I could do that again.' So I gave it a try last year and jumped 5-11. I've really been coming along this year. I lost about 20 pounds and that's been a really big reason for my improvement plus I've got a coach who has been a very big help.

### Lexie Anderson, Pleasant Valley - Winner HS Girls 100-Meter Dash in 12.32- DRAKE RELAYS RECORD

I love the hot weather but today was fine. My fastest this year is 11.99 at the North Scott Invitational. My best part of the race is the start. I've worked on my upper body strength and today it paid off. I'm not completely happy with my time today, just pleased.

This was my first time meeting (Reggie) Davis from Florida A&M and I'm glad I could do it now instead of at the NCAA's. This way I could show him what I've got and check him out too.

I thought it was very nice of Bob Ehrhart to give us a special 400 so I could concentrate on that instead of running two races (prelims and finals).

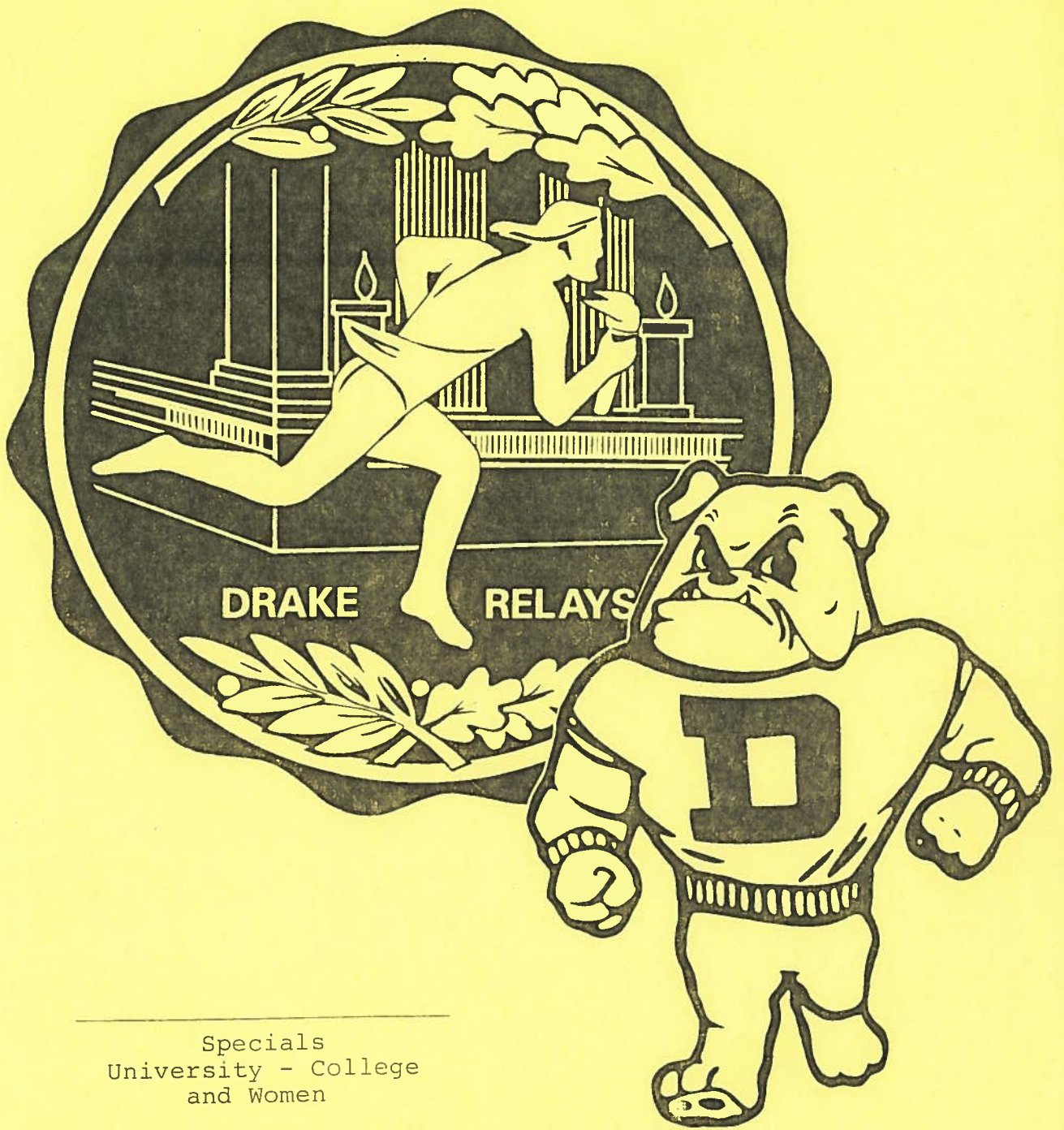
Right now I'm content with just running track and being the best. After '88 then I'll see and maybe I'll go back to football.

### Cathy Branta, Wisconsin, winner Women's 5,000-Meter Run in 15:31.18 DRAKE RELAYS RECORD

When I came off the last turn I just wanted to push it as hard as I could. I wasn't thinking about the college record. I did set out to break the Drake Relays record. I'm glad it turned out like it did.

I liked having the event in the afternoon. The conditions were perfect.

### Revah Knight, Grambling State, anchor on winning Women's 4 x 800-Meter Relay 8:45.22

When I was on the backstretch I was feeling kind of weak but when I got to the curve I just decided to give it all I had. I've had some trouble with my leg and I was going to run the mile relay but my coach let me just concentrate on this race. It was only my third since March 9. Our team is hard working and we always go out to win.

Rod Dehaven, South Dakota State, anchor for winning Distance Medley with 4:03 split, 55 last 400 meters, 9:47.34

This is great. It's incredible really! I'm from South Dakota and I've never experienced anything like this. I don't think any of the guys have.

Once I got around the Cal-Poly guy, I was pretty sure I had it. I tired a little in the stretch though.

### Desmond Ross, Oklahoma State, winner 100-Meter Dash in 10.36

About 40 yards from the finish, I felt pretty good and started pumping my arms and knees. I got a good start and that's really the key to my whole race.

### Michelle Maxey, Kansas State, winner Women's 400 in 52.39

It feels really good, I didn't expect this at all. I just wanted to get out and run my best. I never really felt like I had the race totally in control. It's never over until you pass that finish line.

### Ron Backes, Minnesota, winner University-College Shot Put 61-8 1/4

I've been having some trouble in the middle of the season with my technique. I feel I've been competing well in meets though. I've been working constantly on weights and not really trying to peak for any meets. I've been pretty consistent in distance but I'm trying to work it back up to the mid 60s for NCAAs.

### Paul Emordi, Texas Southern, winner University-College Triple Jump in DRAKE RELAYS RECORD

I had a good series today. It's a pleasure to break the record set by Charlton Ehizueler. We're from the same state in Nigeria. We went to the Penn Relays last year but we're trying to go to different meets this year so I can compete against all the top jumpers. I want to be the best in the world.

I had to slow down by first six steps because the runway is a little shorter than I'm used to. When I came out this morning it was rather cool and I was a little scared. I'm used to the warm weather in Texas. But the sun came out at 1:00 when we started jumping. I'm very happy with this win even though it's off my PR of 56-3 3/4.

### Willie Caldwell, Baylor, second-place Men's Special 400 in 45.56

It was my first time running against Harris. I never had anyone that close to me this year and I got scared so I tied up a little bit and that cost me the race. I got out a little quick. I made up the stagger before I got out of the corner so I should have slowed down a little.

I relaxed a little bit at the head of the stretch and then I found myself in a rut when Harris pulled up beside me. I think I could have outkicked him. I've been running a lot of quarters. 45.56 is an average race for me. I'm going to take a week or two off.

Natasha Kaiser, Roosevelt Des Moines, anchor on HS Girls Sprint Medley Relay.  
winner in DRAKE RELAYS RECORD 1:44.98

I usually come from behind so it was kind of strange to get the baton first. I'm used to passing people. I knew the field was going to be good and I knew Lexie Anderson (of Pleasant Valley) was fast. I was waiting for footsteps.

Terry Brahm, Indiana, anchor of winning dist. med. team 3:59.2 split, 9:32.32

This is the third year I've been here and we've never won one, so it was really special to get one in front of this great crowd.

I was aware of him (Love-Illinois State) and I remembered last year trying to chase him down. I ran pretty conservatively waiting for that last 400. I felt him though. I knew he was there all the time.

Morris Egon, Wayland Baptist, lead-off of winning 4 x 100 relay, 40.01

It is a great atmosphere up here. The crowd is a big help. This is my first time here.

The crowd here reminds me of the Olympics. They really have the Olympic fever, believe me.

Todd Cooper, Baylor, winner pole vault at 18-1

It feels great. Everybody agrees that this is the most prestigious meet in the country. It's an honor to win, it really is. They know how to treat you here and it's just a first-class meet.

I have the second best jump collegiately (18-2) right now. I feel like I'm on schedule right now for nationals.

Byron Clay, Baylor, anchor leg on winning 4 x 100 shuttle relay, 57.10

It was our first time running the shuttle relay this year so we were kind of surprised ourselves. We had two juniors, a sophomore and I'm a freshman on the relay today, so we'd like to come back next year and take it again.

Earl Jones, Eastern Michigan, anchor on winning Univ. Sprint Medley in 3:13.21

I knew Guy would be up front. I said if I was behind I would want to make my move on the backstretch. I think I had a little more strength at the end. We were favored to win but I knew it would be a good race.

I like to run relays better because I don't like having all the glory. I like to share the spotlight with the team.

Raf Wyns, Iowa State, winner University-College 1,500-Meter Run in 3:46.16

I've been training for mostly 5 and 10K races so it was a big surprise I didn't do well yesterday and did so well today. I felt relaxed the whole way but I haven't done any speed work. I was kind of expecting some of the regular 1,500 runners to still be fresh and kick very hard.

Iowa State has won this race three years in a row (Verbeeck '82 and '83, Black '84) so I guess I had to uphold the tradition.

Devon Morris, Wayland Baptist, anchor on winning College 4 x 400-Meter Relay  
DRAKE RELAYS RECORD 3:03.78

Since we set this record in the heats we knew we could beat it in the final. This crowd reminded me of the crowd at the Olympics. It helps me get inspired and makes me run with more determination.
