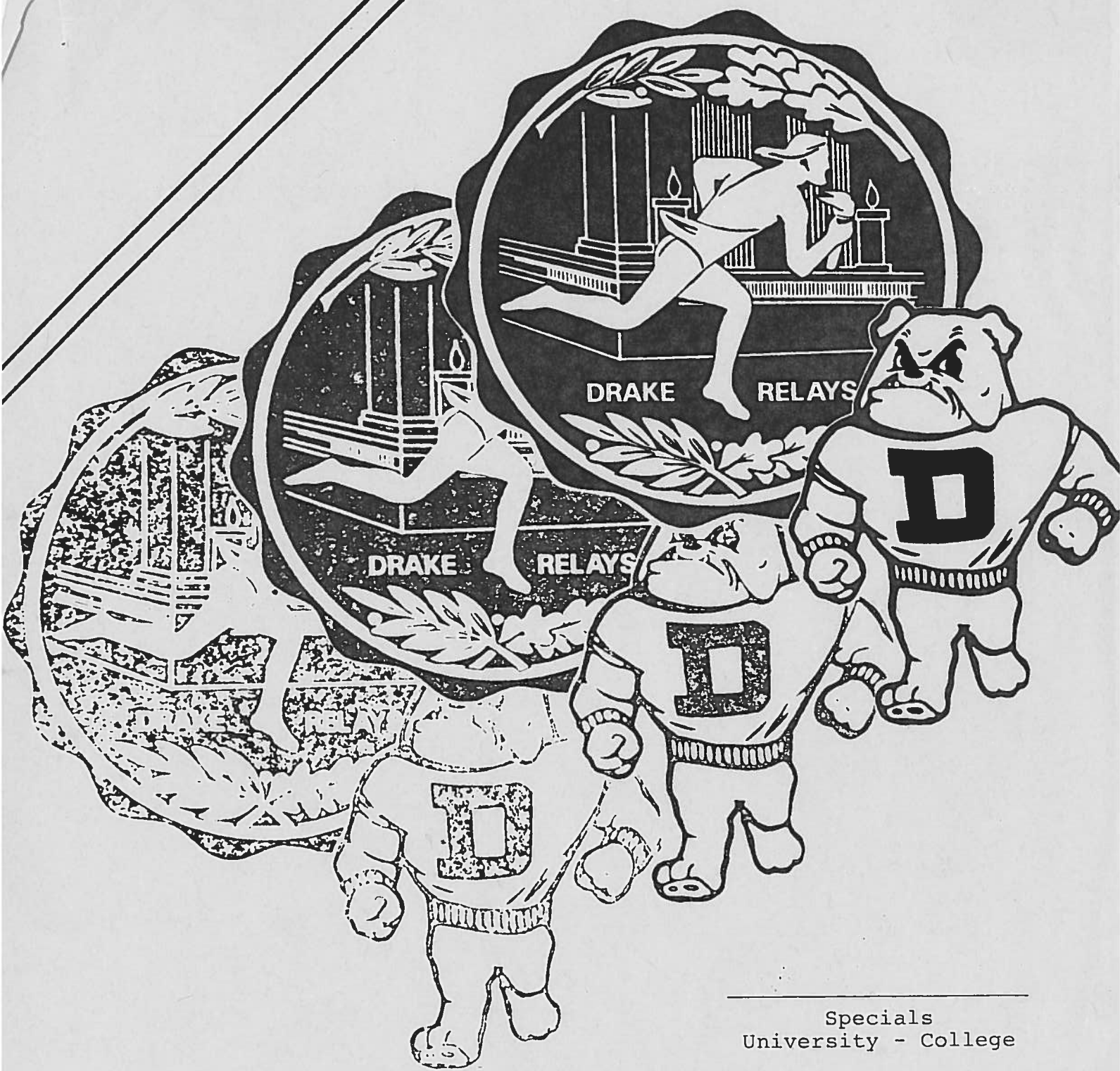

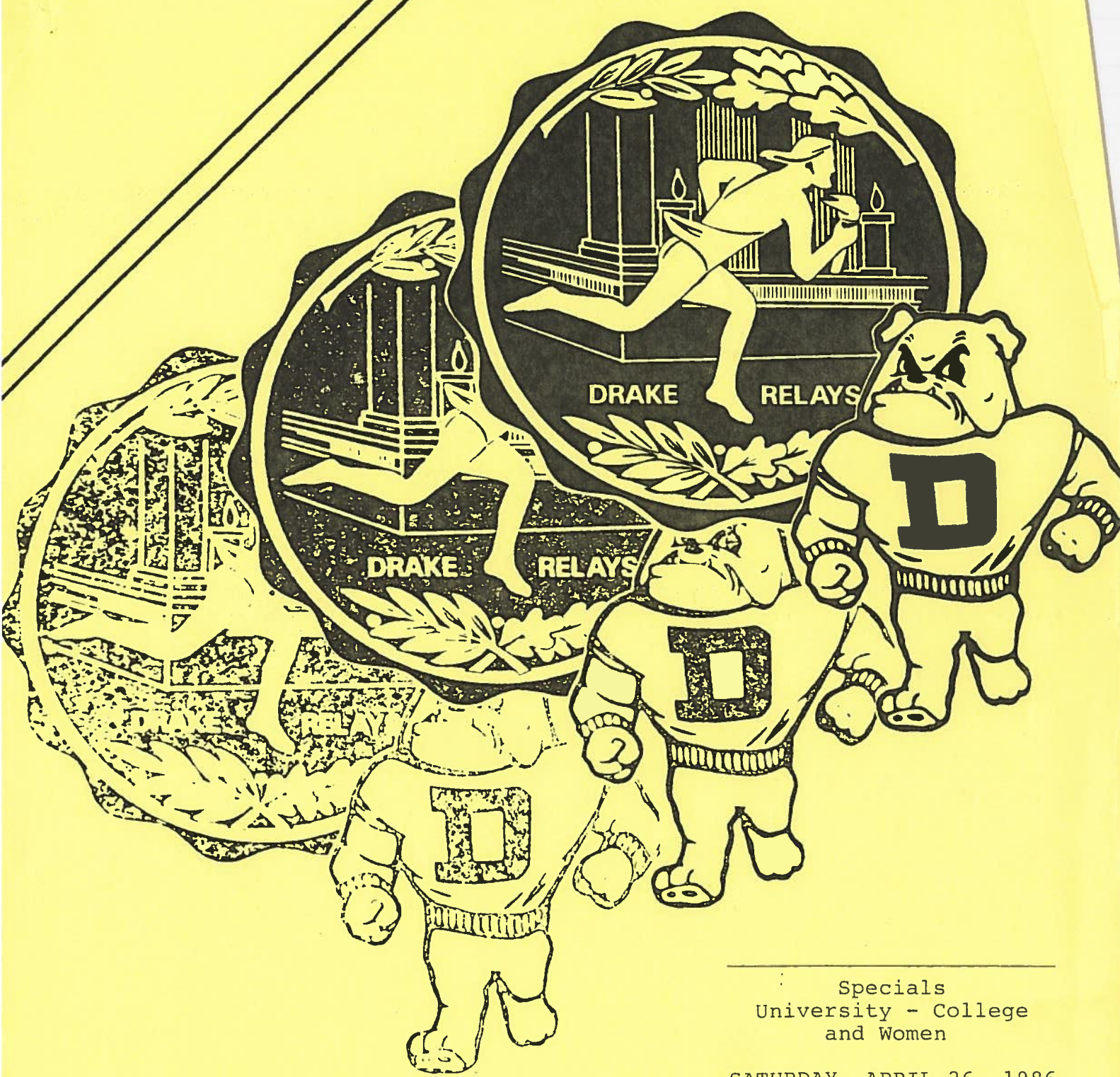

Andrew Parker - Arizona State, WINNER University-College 110-Meter High Hurdles

I was a bit surprised because I had a good field. Talley had beat me for three years in a row. I didn't expect to win this easily. The wind was a factor. I had to get down and really lean over the hurdles. Since I'm so tall I get all the wind.

Natasha Kaiser - Missouri, 2nd in Women's Invitational 400-Meter Dash

I really wanted to go out harder in the first 200 but I didn't get a good start. That's my trademark - poor starts.

There was definitely some added pressure running at the Drake Relays. I've been looking forward to this for 4 years.

Paul Emordi - Texas Southern - WINNER Men's Triple Jump

I don't like the wind. I waited to get a legal jump. I was waiting but the wind just kept coming and coming. I wish they had jumped into the wind. I was surprised this morning when I saw we were jumping with it. I'm in better shape now and I could have gone 55-10 into this wind.

Norman Edwards - Georgia - Anchor on WINNING Men's 4x100-Meter Relay

We just put in Gary Duncan about 30 minutes before the race after Stanley got injured in the 200. Our handoffs were pretty good. He works with us on handoffs and runs the 200 relay. We were pretty happy with that time when you consider it wasn't our regular team. I thought I felt someone on my right there at the end so I did pick it up.

Terry Womack - Oklahoma - WINNER Men's Pole Vault

I jumped at a meet at home last night and then I missed my plane. I had to drive to Dallas at 3:00 a.m. I took the plane from there and didn't arrive here until 11:15 a.m. So I didn't get any run throughs.

I got great winds both times at 17' 8 1/2", but the wind really got me on the last three tries.

The officials here are really strict, but I appreciate that because we would still be vaulting two hours from now otherwise.

Cindy Bremser (who failed to win the 1,500-Meter run--would have been her seventh straight win in the Drake Relays 1,500)

It just didn't feel good today. I was never in a relaxed position. It didn't determine the outcome, but 18 people in that race is way too many.

I really wasn't thinking about the wind. I didn't have time. She (Tina Freba) got too far ahead of me. I had planned on taking the lead at the halfway point, but I couldn't get there. I felt like I couldn't get anywhere. It was real frustrating.

Chidi Imoh, Missouri - WINNER of the Special 100-Meter Dash in a time of 10.37

I came in ready to run. Coach said Emmitt King would be running and he has the fastest time in the Track and Field News. I've run against both King and Calvin Smith before. I haven't beaten them outdoors this year, but I did beat them indoors. I'm not sure of Smith but I feel King is in condition. I felt like I had a good indoor season, with the 6.09 in the 60 indoors coming the NCAA indoors. But then I started poorly in the finals. This is one of the big meets we look forward to at this time of year and look forward to NCAA's. I didn't have much time between the 100 and sprint medley and I was tired.

Lillie Leatherwood - WINNER of Women's 400-Meter Dash in record time of 50.91, breaking old mark of 50.98, which she set in 1984:

We've had bad weather in Minnesota the last couple weeks and I haven't had consistent practices. One day indoors and the next outdoors. It's just not what I need right now. I'm sure I'll be able to hit 70-feet in the NCAA.

Devon Morris, Wayland Baptist - WINNER Men's Special 400-Meter Dash

Today I didn't have a record on my mind, I just went out and ran. I knew I had to run my race because of the breeze on the straightaway there and save a lot for the final 100 meters.

That's the strategy I used today. From the 200 meters on I knew I had the race. I could have run under 45 seconds if I was pushed. I ran my best time against Danny Harris at Kansas, a 45.12
