I've gotten a lot stronger this year coming out of the blocks. I've been working a lot on leg strength. The girl from Des Moines, East (Lisa Edmonds) was right beside me and in fact she was a little ahead during the race. I just ran my heart out.

Russ Schmeichel - Jamestown, North Dakota -- Winner men's masters 800-meter run.
DRAKE RELAYS RECORD 1:58.1

I just turned 40 last August. For the last three years I have only done triathalons. This January I went to Winnipeg, Canada and ran a 1:59.26 indoors and ran some good races in Wisconsin. For the last three months I have been training specifically for this race today.

I had some trouble getting entered in the race. A friend at SDSU was supposed to enter me but we got our signals crossed. Luckily there was a scratch and Coach Ehrhart called me Thursday morning to notify me that I could run. I had to pay \$200 for a plane ticket and I didn't get into Des Moines until midnight last night.

I coach high school track in Jamestown now but I ran in the Drake Relays Marathon in 1971 when I was a graduate student at SDSU. Those last 200 meters were tough but the crowd here was great. They really pulled me through. It reminded me of the Olympic Trial crowds in Eugene.

Nawal El Moutawakel - Iowa State TC -- Winner Women's Invitational 400-Meter Int. Hurdles
I was expecting to be in a tough race today but coach told me to just get out fast. My times were real quick over the first five hurdles. There was a lot of pressure on today but I knew the crowd would never let me down. I felt like I was carried by the way they cheered.

It's always windy and cold in Ames where I train so cold, heat and wind are not a disadvantage for me. I had to win today. I had no excuse for not doing well.

Danny Harris - Athletics West -- Winner Men's Invitational 400-Meter Hurdles

I was happy I won this race but I didn't feel like I ran the prettiest race. I pressed too hard through the first hurdle and then I eased up and my step got off. I panicked for two hurdles and I didn't really know where I was until the straightaway. I ended up going with the right leg for six hurdles. I did have bursitis in my knee last week.

I have anticipated running here at the Drake Relays from the moment I left last year. It pumps me up a lot to see Nawal come out and run before me and win the way she did today. I've run against all these guys before so today was basically against the clock.

I will not be running tomorrow. This was it for me. I will definitely be back to the Drake Relays next year.

Felicia Carpenter - Kansas State -- Winner Women's Invitational Triple Jump

The one time today that I tried to stop and wait for the wind to die down was the time I scratched. It's awfully tough to get the record with the wind switching around.

Last year I got the record but Yvonne Netterville of Purdue won because she had a wind-aided jump that was longer. I really wanted to win this year and I was disappointed that the jump won't get into the record book.

This was only my second outdoor race of the season. I knew that I would go below the record. This was my third run against Smith. He beat me once and I won in Zurich last year.

I beat Carl Lewis in a TAC meet earlier and that proved to me that I can win against anyone.

Manley Waller - Georgia -- Winner Men's Univ. & Col. 100-Meter Dash

All those false starts fatigued me some. My best start come on the second, after that first start when the gun didn't work.

I wanted to uphold the Georgia tradition here. It's a big deal to me now in my senior year and to Coach Gainey to do well at the Drake Relays. The people all treat us so well. In turn we want to run well for them.

Rod Woodson - Purdue -- second in Univ. & Col. 100-Meter High Hurdles

I just hit too many hurdles down the stretch. This was only my third race outdoors. I'm still trying to get my running legs underneath me.

I'm going to be nervous on the trip back home with the NFL draft coming up on the 28th.

Adina Valdez - Jackson State -- anchor on winning Women's Invitational 4x800-Meter Relay

We don't really have a 4x800 meter team. This is only our second 4x800 this year. I just went out and ran the best I could.

I guess she (the Iowa anchor) was tired and I was tired but the stronger one wins.

Colette Gourdreau - Indiana -- Winner Women's Invitational 1,500-Meter Run

Last year when I came here, I did awful, but I have had pretty good training and it felt pretty good. The field was really good, and I was pushed by all the others. My strategy was just to get out in the lead and stay there.

Keith Talley - Alabama -- Winner Univ. & Col. 100-Meter High Hurdles

I felt more confident today; I wasn't mentally prepared yesterday and that's why I ran such a slow time. I'm glad I made the finals.

I ran next to Ron Woodson, and we used to duel in high school. He's from Fort Wayne, Indiana and I'm from Indianapolis. I knew if I ran my race, I would win. I have a slow weak start, so I thought I have to start fast and finish strong.

Lillie Leatherwood-King - Alabama -- Winner Women's Invitational 400-Meter Dash, set a new record in the event with a time of 50.64, breaking her 1986 record of 50.91

It's tradition to come and do well at the Drake Relays. (On hearing that she had broken her old record). It feels great. I was hoping I would do better.

(Speaking of her husband, Emmitt King) We always cheer each other on. We know how track is...we understand each other.

Nawal El Moutawakel - Iowa State -- finished third in Women's Invitational 400-Meter Dash

I didn't expect to run this good. I've been gaining my strength back. I've had a lot of struggles in my life...I've had knee surgery and one of my coaches passed away.

My coach and I talk about strategy during the race. I just explode and use my power and think of winning. At one point, I led in the race. At the 300-meter mark, I was almost fifth. I said to myself, you have to run faster, and I ended in third place.

David Bond - Kansas -- Winner Men's Univ. & Col. Triple Jump

I've had a heal bruise and haven't had much of a chance to practice. This was a PR for me. I think my timing was finally coming around. I waited for the wind to die down on every jump so that was not a factor. I prefer to jump without a wind rather than with a wind.

Maria Usifo - Texas Southern -- Winner Women's Invitational 100-Meter Hurdles

My mind was made up on winning. I wasn't coming to run a fast race. I've been nursing a knee injury. I hurt my knee when I hit a hurdle at the World Championships in Indianapolis. I think I'll be resting a little before the NCAA's.

I plan to stay in Houston and train for the Olympics. I'm sure I can qualify for the Nigerian team. I was a semifinalist at L.A. in '84.

Stanley Kerr - Texas A&M - Anchor on winning Men's University 4x100-Meter Relay

I didn't think our final handoff was that good. But it turned out we ran a PR. We know ~~when~~ we had the race coming in. We were very comfortable and relaxed. By the end of the season I think we can run a 38.3.

James Rolle - Wayland Baptist -- Anchor on winning Men's College 4x100-Meter Relay

Butch Reynolds and I ran together for Bud Light TC in 1983. I ran 44.73 and he was doing low 45's. I sat out for the last two years. I'm running as a freshman.

The program at Wayland is just super. The coaches there create an atmosphere that's like home away from home. They value your opinion and are always willing to help. They take athletes that other schools won't look at and give kids a second chance. That's why I'm there. After being out for two years they've really helped me.

Chidi Imoh - All-Star International - Winner Special 100-Meter Dash in time of 10.17

I was pleased with the race today, it was my first race. I'm not in great shape, I didn't run indoors either. My best in this event is 10 flat, today's time is my best this year. I wasn't real loose. I'm looking forward to the World Championships and hopefully to the 1988 Olympics.

Calvin Smith - Team Adidas -- Finished second in both Men's Invitational 100 & 200-Meter Dashes

There are a lot of things I should have done before coming to this meet. I'm in the process of moving to Florida and that has taken time away from my training.

I ran against some very good runners. I'm very pleased with my performance. Chidi Imoh is a very good runner. When I'm training and more competitive I think I can win. The Drake Relays are a very good meet for both competitors and fans. The fans give the athletes a sense of great support and make the athletes want to put on a good show.

Time Wakeland - Iowa State -- Winner Univ. & Col. 3,000-Meter Steeplechase

I started out a little slower than I usually do. I just wanted to hang back with the pack. The pace was a little too slow and that's why I took the lead. My adrenalin started pumping so I made by third, fourth, fifth and sixth laps count. I was dead the last lap.

I used to be a high hurdler, but I switched to the steeplechase my freshman year. My coach told me that's the only event I could be competitive in in the Big Eight.

Harry "Butch" Reynolds - Ohio State -- Winner Men's Special 400-Meter Dash

This is my first time at the Drake Relays. I've been excited all week. The Drake Relays are pretty inspiring.

The race went pretty good, but I feel I can go a lot faster. I wasn't fatigued at the end. I was waiting for someone to come up on me but they didn't. I can do a lot better than this with the right group in the right race.

Pinkie Skuggs - Kansas State -- Winner Women's Invitational Shot Put and Discus

I've just had a great year so far. When I came to Des Moines on Thursday I knew I'd break the record in the shot because I've been at 54 feet consistently. I didn't know what would happen in the discus. I had a feeling I was going to break the record but not by 12 feet.

In the shot I just tried to stay torqued and straight in the back. My record throw was so smooth that it didn't even feel like 55 feet.

I love the crown here at Drake. There are a lot of things going on but everyone watches all the events, not just the track.

Alfonzo Henson, Alabama - Anchor on winning Men's University Sprint Medley Relay

I was thinking we'd be way out ahead of the field when I got the baton. Actually, I prefer to be in second so I knew we were in good shape when I took off. If I had known we were so close to the record I would have sprinted at the end. I had a whole lot left.

I think we're about equal to the Alabama team with Calvin Smith and William Wuyke that set this record back in 1983. William is coaching me now while he trains for the World Championships.

Adriane Diamond, Indiana - Winner Women's Invitational 800-Meter Run

This was only my third time running this event. I had no idea how to run it. I got tired of fighting with the other runners so I moved out in the third 200. I'm a quarter miler moving up so I knew I could outkick anyone else. I think I've found my race.
