

Darwin Vande Hoef. Rock Valley: Winner, High School Boys High Jump at 6-11

It was good to win, but I was a little disappointed I didn't go higher. Other times I've cleared 6-10 and then gone right to 7-1. My legs felt good, but my hurdles were a little short. You never know how you feel until you start to jump, but at 6-5, I could tell I was going in

to the bar; leaning in too much.

The Drake record (of 7-3) was definitely in my mind, but I couldn't get it. The grass was a little slippery and we were jumping into a bit of a wind.

Brian Ferry, Dubuque: Winner, High School Boys Pole Vault at 13-0

I really wanted it because this is my last year competing. I broke my arm playing basketball

last year, so I was happy to win.

I think Iowa is getting ready to ban the pole vault after this year, so the win is a little more special. There were a lot more people last year, but it's sort of being phased out. I don't feel it's a dangerous event.

Renita Robinson, Nebraska: Winner, Women's Triple Jump at 41-3 1/4 (12.58)

I think my first jump was the only jump I had that wasn't wind impeded. There was a strong headwind. I had a challenge as far as my attitude was concerned right before the meet, so I wasn't attitudinally in the right frame of mind.

It would have been a good idea to jump in the other direction. There was some talk about it earlier, but they wouldn't have been able to change it between the prelims and the finals. We would've had a tailwind going the other way and had wind-aided jumps. But they felt it was best

to keep it there.

On Joanne Gomez, Robinson's Nebraska teammate who also qualified for the finals: Joanne's been a tremendous help to me. The first year I was at Nebraska, I didn't really have a training partner and now she helps me. It's not a rivalry, it's more a motivational factor. We give each other a couple feet per meet. I gave her two feet, so she actually beat me.

Brett Carney, Jowa State: Third leg runner (3:58.7) of 4 x 1,600 Relay at 16:14.08.

The mile relay is kind of a special event at Iowa State and when coach asked me to run, I said I'd give it a shot. Not having run it before, I didn't know what to expect. I didn't know I'd get Thornton (Louisiana State's third leg runner). I was waiting him out and I promised my self I'd get him in the last hundred meters because I'm a half-miler and he's a distance runner.

It's great to win here. The meet you look forward to all year is the Drake Relays. This year

with Jim Duncan not being here, it takes a little bit away, but it's still a lot of fun.

<u>Darwin Vande Hoef, Rock Valley</u>: Winner, High School Boys 110-Meter High Hurdles in 14.59.

All I wanted to do was run a good time and win. I felt I came out of the blocks a little slow but my best race is always over the last five hurdles. I think I did real well there today. Having a second win feels very good but I still have the long jump and the 400 hurdles to go. I'm just concentrating on doing my best in every event this weekend.

Lia Pierson, Ames: Winner, High School Girls 100-Meter Dash in 12.46

I could see (second place finisher) Toria (Simmons, of Ames) out of the corner of my eye and I knew I had to pick it up. This is the first time we've run together in the open 100 in a big meet other than at state. Our coach usually tries to put us in different events because we both like to win.

Connie Long, Wichita State: Winner, Women's College-University Division at 6-0

The Drake Relays are such a super place to come. I love the crowd and the event. I was hoping to win today. I've been real consistent at six-foot. I wanted to go up to 6-1, but... I'm peaking for the NCAA's.

I really like jumping when it's hot, up in the 90's, but I wanted to win this one so badly, I

didn't care if it was cold, rainy or anything.

Comments from members of winning Iowa Women's Distance Medley Relay team: (This was the first Drake Relays victory by the Iowa women.)

Kim Schneckloth: "We knew that if we had the lead going into the anchor leg we would

have a good chance to win.

Jeanne Kruckeberg: We felt we could win and it's especially satisifying to do it here. It was nice to walk up to the starting line before the race and hear all the fans encourage us."

Victoria Fulcher, unattt.: Winner, 400 Intermediate Hurdles, 56.75

In the preliminaries, I had the second fastest time and I knew I'd be up against the fastest (Linetta Wilson, Nebraska). I also knew I won it last year and I wanted to win it again.

I've only run the race one other time this year, so I was a little apprehensive on how my

time would be.

I'm unattached this year, so I'll be running more with club people instead of college. I'm going to San Jose next month (May 26) to run against Jackie Joyner -- and that'll be a race.

Dave Knight, Ames: Winner, High School Boys 100 Dash, 10.71

I'm surprised I came on at the end of the race. I just tried to come out of the blocks a little too hard and bumped into him (Kenny Shedd of Davenport West). We both kind of came up. My elbow hit his fist and I'm sure it slowed him up.

The 100 is not my race, but I'll take the victory. This is my favorite because it's the

shortest, but it's not my best.

Toward the middle of the race, my ham got kind of tight, but I strided it out.

I like the feeling of winning against people who were ranked higher than me. There were lots of people who I'd beaten in high school, but rated ahead.

Comments from the Cal-Poly Pomona Relay team, winner of the 4 x 800 College Division

Michael Spindler (ran achor leg) -- I ran my own pace on the back stretch. I kept relaxed and I knew I had a good kick.

Marc Spina (ran second leg) -- I feel great with the title. We came here to win the 4 x 800 and the distance medley, so we're halfway there.

Stephane Franke (ran leadoff) -- I thought he (Spindler) was going to be overtaken, but I knew he was a super kicker. We're a team with two Germans, an Ethiopian and an American, so I knew we'd win.

Darwin Vande Hoef, Rock Valley: Winner, High School Boys 400 Low Hurdles, 53:06

This was a little farther than the 110. It's just a great feeling winning three titles, I can't even describe it. I'll just say it's a lot of fun. I just tried to go out and do my best, but winning all three was a little above my expectations. I kind of wanted to prove myself in this race.

I knew I'd have to beat the defending champion (Brent Roth, Iowa City), and I knew he

could run a lot better.

It's hard to explain, I'm just happy to have done it, and live on.

Mary Onyali, Texas Southern: Anchor on winning 4 x 200 Relay, University-College Division (1:31.96 - Collegiate Record)

We never thought about setting a record. I just knew I had to run away from her (Louisiana State's Dawn Sowell) and run toward the finish. I thought of my leg, I thought of the weather and I just kept going; I knew if I felt anything, I could stop.

We're big rivals (Louisiana State), they've been on us all the time. We thought if they

(LSU) won, it's all right; if we win, that 'd be great. But we were ready.

Terrance Herrington, Clemson: Anchor on winning Univ. 4 x 800-Meter Relay in 7:19.47

I took the baton slightly ahead but I slowed down hoping Hamer (of Illinois) would pass me. I'm not fond of running in front. I can run much better behind the leader. I was expecting it to be a fast leg but I was in front and I don't like to run 800s in front.

I didn't feel that good today either, my legs were kind of tight. We weren't concentrating on the time today, we just wanted to concentrate on the victory.

John Nichols, LSU: Winner, Men's Univ.-Col. Discus in 206-4 1/2 (63.04) DRAKE RELAYS RECORD

The record throw came on my last throw. The others had been in the 203-range. I had a recent back injury that reoccurred and I'm just trying to train around it and get healthy for the rest of the season. My personal goal this year is 210 given my injuries.

I'm a sophomore and I just turned 19 not too long ago. I haven't been throwing that long so I'm still trying to learn. In high school at Winfield, Louisiana, I basically had to coach myself.

It feels great to break the record but I don't get too much satisfaction out of individual throws, just as long as we do well as a team. Saturday, April 29, 1989

Monica Joyce, Ireland (unattached): Winner, Women's 5000-Meter Run in 16:01.

I was hoping for a little faster time, but it was pretty windy out there. I ran a 10,000 meters last week in a personal best, so I think I'm a little fatigued. It's taken me a week to recover from last week and with the wind and the cold, it really wasn't very comfortable out there, but I was fortunate I got away early and I didn't have anyone out there trying to push the pace.

It doesn't matter if someone is pushing the pace, if I'm feeling good, I can run well either way. I was hoping for a 15:30 today, but my arms got numb with the wind and cold. I've been running very good this year and I think I'm ready to run fast. April has been pretty busy so I'm going to take a week off and road race the rest of the year.

It's been great here. I've heard so much about Drake and I've never been. I'm a little disappointed I couldn't have made it more exciting for the crowd.

Arne Schraeder, Unattached: Winner, Men's 5000-Meter Run in 13:55.72

I just started my speed work at the beginning of April. I was in shape today to run a 13:35 or so but conditions were not the best.

Sylvia Brydson, Louisiana State: Anchor, Winning Women's U-C 4 x 800-Meter Relay in 8:47.49

I knew she (Jeanne Kruckeberg of Iowa) was behind me and she had gotten me indoors (at the NCAA Championships), so I decided to maintain as best I could. It was hard to stay loose, so I was basically striding. I kind of felt h/er and I knew I could hold her off.

Last year it was funny because, the crowd and the atmosphere got me so psyched and I went out a little too fast on my first lap. This year I told myself I wouldn't do that.

Michael Spindler, Cal-Poly Pomona: Anchor on Winning Men's College Distance Medley Relay in 9:57.48

I wasn't that worried when I got the lead from the third runner, but I would have perferred to be two meters behind, so I can run the whole race behind him and outkick at the end. A two-meter lead is nothing. He (David Kipelio of Emporia State) had a big advantage, but he couldn't kick me.

I felt pretty good. I slowed down the pace a little bit, because I didn't want it to wear me out at the end. I took it down to the last lap and outkicked him.

Richard Bucknor, Texas A&M: Winner, Men's U-C 110-Meter High Hurdles in 13.90

I thought it would be a tough race, but it was only the second hurdles for me all year, so it was pretty good. I've been working a lot on my start and I got off pretty fast. I had to run in my tights today and I hate that. It might have been why I hit some hurdles. In warmer weather, I have a better chance of getting more flexibility. I thought I ran pretty good for this time of the year.

Tanajalyn Stanley, Louisiana State: Winner, Women's 100-Meter Hurdles in 13:05.

Last year was better because it was hot, but I love the crowd at Drake. I felt better running yesterday, but I broke on hurdle seven. My start was really good. My coach said I had to learn not to break and keep accelerating. That's exactly what I did. I kept pumping my arms and driving.

If someone breaks my record, I'll just have to come back here next year and defend.

Andre Cason, Texas A&M: Winner, Men's U-C 100-Meter Dash in 10.1 and (Third leg) on winning University 4 x 100-Meter Relay.

I was unhappy with the starting blocks today. They didn't have any adjustable pressure plates on them. But I just wanted to get out as quick as I could.

As of yesterday, I've had my jaw wired for 4 1/2 weeks. It was a little squabble I tried to break up and I just caught a right hook, that's all.

On Relay: I'm a little disappointed about what happened over by the handoff area. I think we could have run it a lot faster. I wasn't paying attention. I don't know what happened, but I can promise you it'll never happen again. I was on the inside of the turn instead of the outside. My head was in my butt, and we paid for it.

Todd Patterson, Gran View College: Third leg on Winning College 4 x 100-Meter Relay in 41.51

How did we do it? That man right there (anchor Obina Eregbu). We all did our parts. I knew if I kept it close, Obina was going to bring it home for us. When I handed off the baton, I was confident. At first I was nervous because I didn't want to be overconfident, be we all came through.

Pauline Davis, Alabama: Winner, Women's 400-Meter Dash in 50.83

I had to really work hard today. I had a long season last year with the Olympics and I really struggled indoors this spring. I had a foot operation and I was out of track for two weeks. I hadn't really done any running until I got here. This is my last year at Drake and I wanted it to end on a good note.

Natasha Kaiser, Missouri: Second in Women's 400-Meter Dash in 51.09

I lost my concentration today. This is the first time I've had the lead that long. I ran a pretty good 300 meters. In the last 100 I forgot to pick my knees up, but now...that's done.

Kevin Little, Drake: Winner, Men's Special Invitational 200-Meter Dash in 20.59

Today, since it was so cold out, I took about an extra 1/2 hour to warm up -- my legs were feeling good but before the race I was mentally prepared and I think that's what helped me the most. The crowd really got me going. I came off the turn and kept my arm speed up and everything went just as planned.

I was a little disappointed I didn't have anybody to chase on the outside of me but I just ran my race. I did feel a lot of pressure today, but I just wanted to go out and run my best, win or lose.

Jeanne Kruckenberg, Iowa: Winner, Women's 1500-Meter Run in 4:25.00

I didn't really know how I was going to run going into it, because I wasn't sure I was ready after the 4 x 800 relay. So I just hung back for awhile. Then, when the pace was so slow, I knew I would have a good final lap.

Well, I used to be a person who on the last 200 I'd just go full out. But my coach told me I'd have to be a long kicker today because Jane Booker is a good sprinter and in order to beat her I'd have to draw her out. So early in the last lap I said 'Okay, I'm going.

Mary Onyali, Texas Southern: Anchor on Winning Women's 4 x 100-Meter Relay in 44.20

I think our time today was better than yesterday. This was my last event and I'm glad. We didn't come here last year, but the year before. It came down to us and LSU by the third leg. But after the final hand off, I didn't know what happened.

Joe James, Des Moines East: Anchor on Winning H.S. Boys 4 x 100-Meter Relay in 42,26

We knew we had a shot at the record last year at state. We worked on our baton for about two hours today, we didn't really work on speed. The handoffs today were great, just perfect.

With the crowd yelling, I thought someone was coming up on me so I ran faster. I think we can run in the low 41's before the season is over. It's going to take a lot of practice.

Christa Holmes, Valley of WDM: Anchor on Winning H.S. Girls Sprint Medley Relay in 1:51.99

This one was actually easier than the 4 x 400 prelims. I felt a little more loose. It wasn't that bad coming in at the end because you couldn't really feel the wind, there was too much to think about with the other runners.

It was a close finish, there were four of us right there. Jenny Ray (of Marshalltown) was right in front of me on the homestretch and I thought that we had third place. I got a spurt of energy all of a sudden and I just said "go with it" and we came out ahead. We were lucky.

Opal Cunningham, L.S.U.: Anchor on Winning Women's Sprint Medley Relay in 1:40.29

I felt good all the way down. I hope it was a good time. We were already in the lead when I took over so I just tried to go as fast as I could until I died. There wasn't any particular strategy.

Paul Ereng, Virginia: Winner, Men's Special Invitational 800-Meter Run in 1:47.0

(On coming from the back of the pack): I tried to run one day from in front and almost died. The weather bothered me a lot but just at the start of our race it became sunny for about three minutes and then it got cloudy again and I think that was good for me. I like to run when it's about 75 degrees.

This is a fast track and a fast place. If the weather was 75 today and with the competition the way it was I could have run a 1:44 here today. This is my second outdoor race of the year.

Lance Elliott, Montezuma: Winner, High School Boy's 1600-Meter Run in 4:18.25

After I won the 3,200 I was pretty confident I could be a two-time winner at the Drake Relays. I didn't really decide until two weeks ago that I was going to run in both the mile and the two mile. But after I saw that I had a really fast qualifying time in the 3,200 I decided that I'd be wasting my time if I didn't run in both so I entered and I'm glad I did.

Terrence Herrington, Clemson: Winner, Men's U-C 1500-Meter Run in 3:46.73

I kind of wanted to sit back and kick like I did today. I got kind of scared because I didn't know that guy from UTEP, I hadn't seen him before. He was out in front but he wasn't really going anywhere.

This has been a great meet. I've never been to a track meet in America where you get so much fan support except maybe the National Championship.

James Morris, Nebraska: Winner Men's U-C Triple Jump at 52-6 3/4

It was a fair performance. I had bigger jumps that I fouled on. I told somebody 51 feet would win it because of the conditions. As the conditions improved, the jumps got better. I'll take it. I should have jumped 54, but I was pleased. It's nice to get a major win like this. It goes in the record books. I can't wait to call my mom and tell her I won the Drake Relays.

Kevin Little, Drake: Winner, Men's Special Invitational 400-Meter Dash in 46.75

Winning here is a special feeling. You don't get it anywhere else. I think the crowd kept me in the race when they started yelling for me with 100 meters left.

Well, I knew if I ran what I had been all season, I had as good a chance as anybody else to win. I was a little lucky to get two titles. I was just concentrating on the 200. The only thing I thought about the 400 was that I would run in it.

Sandra Latham, Alabama: Third leg on Winning Jim Duncan 4 x 400-Meter Relay in 3:34.91

I knew I had to get the race closer, because we wanted to win it again. So I told Pauline (Davis) that I was going for it on my leg. I didn't feel we would lose, but I didn't know what I had. But when I started to run, I knew we'd do well.

I had no doubts about Pauline because I know what she's capable of running.

Doug Abel, Northwest Iowa: Anchor on Winning Dr. Channing Smith 4 x 400-Meter Relay in 3:14.98

I was hoping to hold on. Yesterday, I knew (North Dakota State's Norm) McGhee didn't run his best and I knew we had to get out early if we wanted to hold him off. All year, we've usually been beating people by 30 or 40 meters, but we knew today would be tough. We just ran like we thought we would. We're used to running in this kind of weather all year.

Michael Johnson, Baylor: Anchor on Winning John L. Griffith 4 x 400-Meter Relay in 3:04.30

I felt like we brought six people here who could run, I thought we could run pretty comfortably with whoever we started. We just try, whether we're in front or behind, to put as much distance between ourselves and the next person.

I've had my best race running from behind, but I rather wind up in front because that tells you right there everyone else has done their efforts and put their heart into it.

Felecia Allen, Missouri: Winner Women's U-C Long Jump at 20-9

I feel great about winning, it's all right. I thought I'd do well here, but I didn't expect to win it. There were some real strong competitors. I was just looking to do a PR-personal best. But I didn't expect my personal best to be the winner. It was only one-quarter of inch better, but for me that's a lot.
