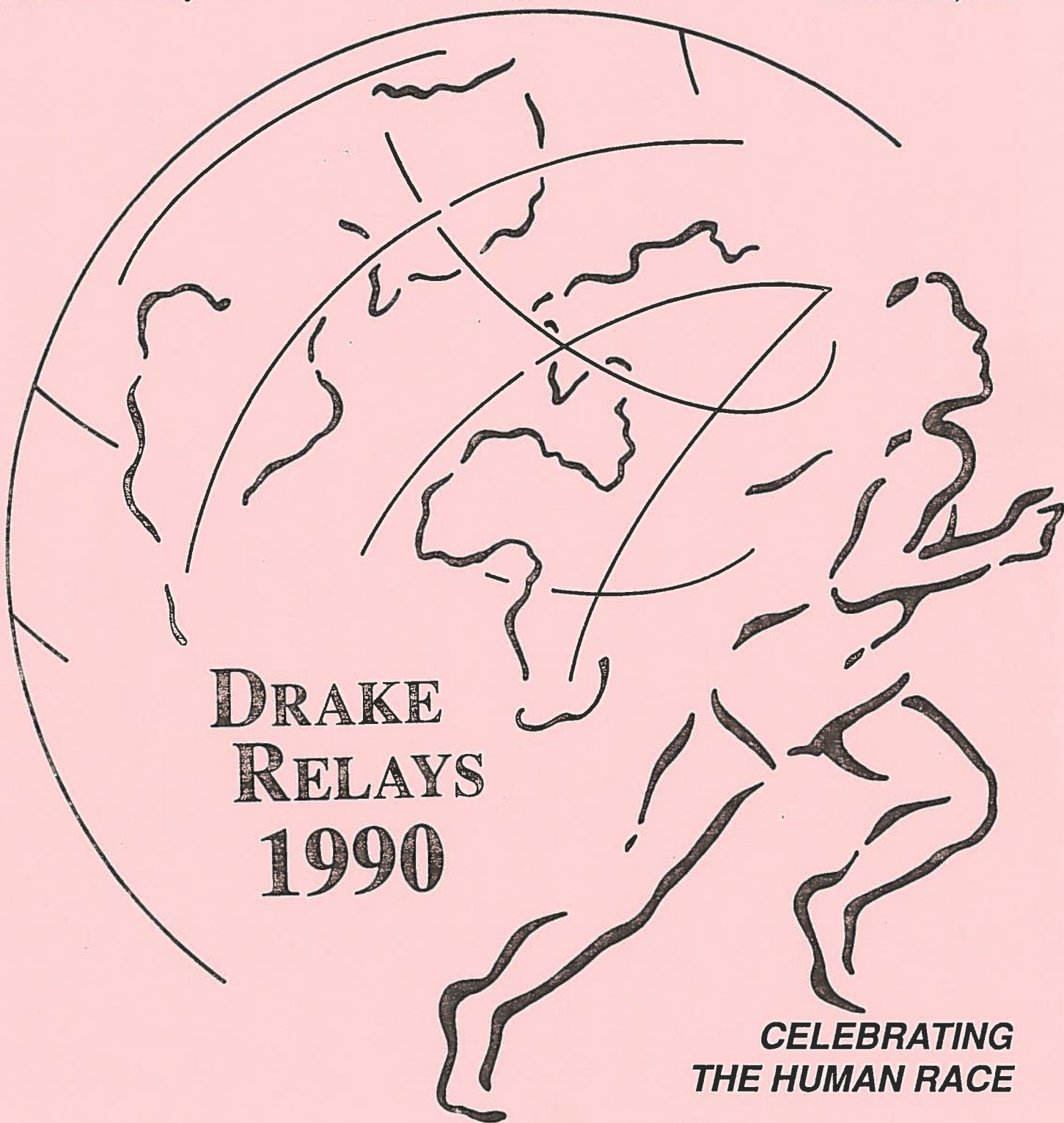

 --Janvrin moves into the No. 3 spot on the overall Drake Relays career victory list with four titles.
 --He becomes the fourth performer in the 81-year history of the Drake Relays to have won an event at least four straight years, joining: Debbie Carroll, Collins Ia. , girls' prep 100 (1971-74); Mel Lattany, Georgia, university-college 100 (1978-81) and Cindy Bremser, Wisconsin Track Club, women's 1500-meter run (1978-81).

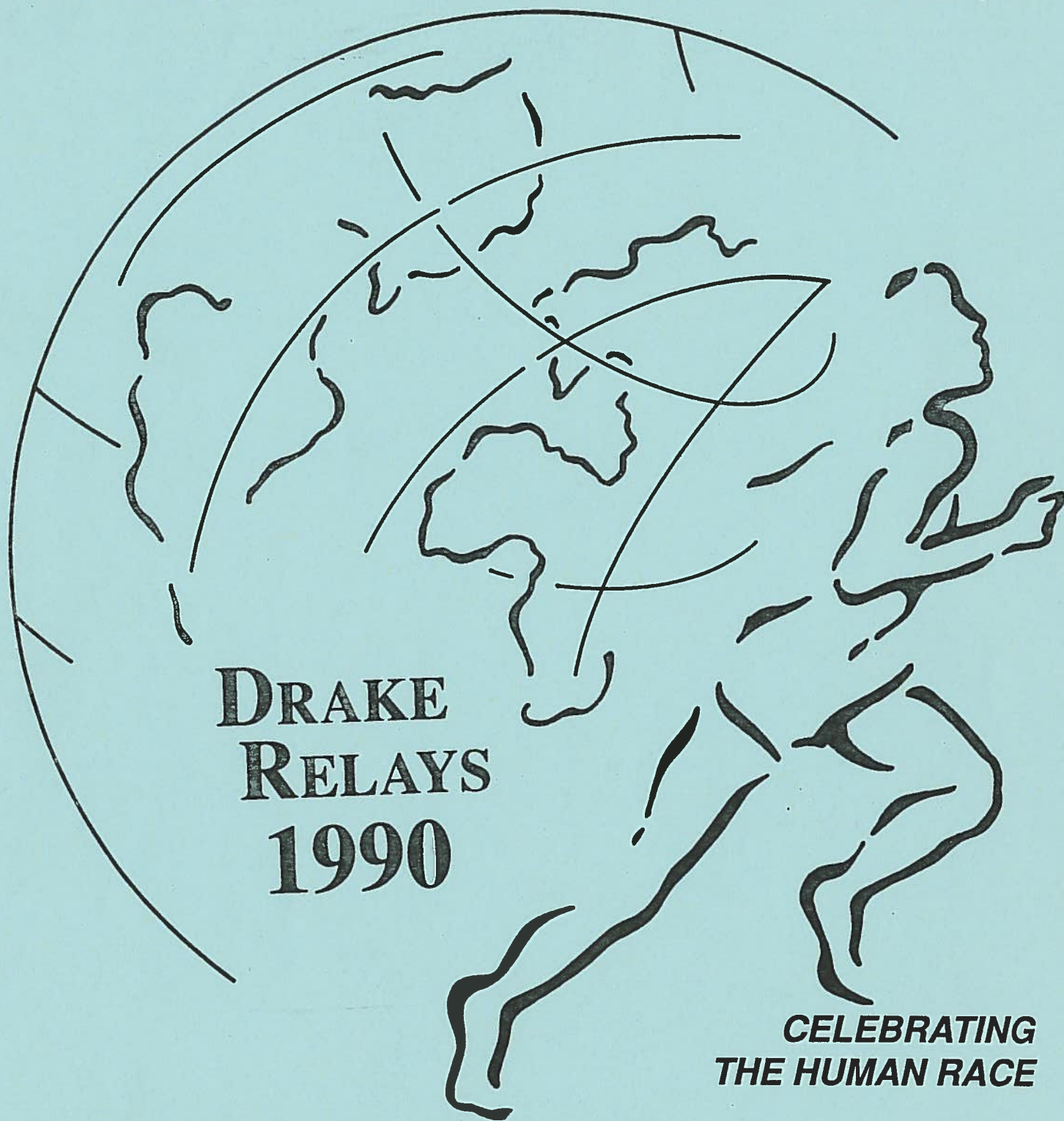

The last 160 meters she (Loboiko) really sprinted and I wasn't ready for that. I'm always strong at the finish but I didn't feel tired at the end. I didn't really use up everything but because of the lack of training I'm not sure I was really ready to anyway.

I felt my time was weak. The first lap was just so-so and I could have done better. It is very early in the season for us and we are training for big meets this summer.
