

It would have been nice to have a clean win at 6-9 but given the conditions I'm happy with this jump. I'm glad the rain let up so we could get through the first round. My plant is my toe so the wet surface didn't bother me as much as the guys who plant with their heel. I think I'm going to go out and buy a pair of high jump shoes now. They have heel spikes. I've been wearing the same track spikes I bought off a kid in 8th grade. They're working though.

Lynne Frey, Nebraska: Winner, Women's Javelin, 49.36 (161-11)

It was a little hard to get warmed up and get moving. Everything was wet, including my shoes. The wind was coming head on which is great but I wasn't able to take full advantage of it. I was pleased to get off a throw in the same range as my PR throw of 162-1 last week at Kansas. I finished third in the Drake Relays Heptathlon last year and didn't compete in the open javelin here. This year I'm concentrating on the javelin and that has really helped me improve.

Cynthia Moore, Arkansas: Winner, Women's Triple Jump, 12.24 (40-2)

I felt okay even though it was a little cool out here this morning. I've had to compete in the rain at just about every meet this spring and today was no different. I've still got lots of things to work on but I'll be patient and they will come soon.

John Nuttall, Iowa State: Anchor on Winning Men's U-C 4x1600-Meter Relay in 16:25.37

We knew we had a strong team and that we were favored to win. When we woke up this morning it was raining and cold so we knew the record might not be possible. It's a tough record. We decided to just concentrate on the win. For me, it was nice to take it easy. I just enjoyed the race and the victory.

The streak (now 5 in a row) began the first year I was at Iowa State. This is my last time but we've got three guys coming back and the Coach Bergan has some good prospects so I hopefully we can keep it going and make it 10 in a row.

Donnie Stecher, Iowa City: W inner, High School Boys 100-Meter Dash in 11.20

This is my biggest win. This is a starting block. My dream is to go on and win state. I usually get out to a fast start so this race was unusual for me. But in the last fifteen to twenty meters I kicked it in. This is incredible. I have gotten stronger (from last year) and that is the big difference.

Mary Beth Labosky. University of Kansas: Winner, University Women's High Jump,

I have been working at this height all season and have been coming close. Now there will not be any barriers for me. I was able to jump well today due to concentrating on my technique. I knew if I kept that focus then everything would eventually come together and it did today. I focused on doing things right.

This is my first Drake Relays and I love it here. I heard about the people in the stands. This is fantastic. My first Relays... and I do a personal best. From here I hope to qualify for the nationals.

Brett Carney, Iowa State: Anchor of Winning Mens University 4x800 Meter Relay in 7:20.31

James (Hall) flat out ran the race of his life. He sparked us when he worked his way from sixth to first place.

We know what the relays mean... in front of a large home crowd and outstanding competition. We knew we could run better than we did at the indoor nationals. We knew all along that we could do it but it wasn't easy. When he (Cecil Shy) passed me, it brought back a memory from high school when we went to the wire. But at that point, the tremendous support of the crod triggered something inside me and I took off. This race makes us more intent on working hard and moving forward.

Bridget Smyth, Arizona: Anchor on Winning Women's Distance Medley Relay in 11.11.18 -Drake Relays Record.

We haven't run together before as a relay team but we were all within the top one or two in our respective specialties so we knew we could do well if we just stayed close. We didn't know what all these Midwester and Eastern teams could do. In the southwest the longer relay races aren't as common.

I just ran the first lap easy and then at about 500 meters I snuck a peek and didn't see anybody behind me so I ran steady through to the end. Nobody expected us to be in contention this year. We lost three guys from our team that finished second last year.

Tashika Lewis, Des Moines North: Winner High School Girls Invit. 100-Meter Dash in 12.89

Before the race I had a lot of people telling me to warm up a lot and get out of the blocks fast. I still have a lot of work to do on the start. I didn't really start running until the 8th grade. I moved up to Des Moines from Louisiana and didn't really know of any track clubs.

Kim Carson (of Des Moines Roosevelt) and I have been friends for a while now and, with all due respect to her I knew that to win I would have to stay even with her all the way. It was close. I'm still nervous now.

Sammie Gdowski, Club Sota: Winner, Women's Invit. 5,000-Meter Run in 16:13.67

This was my first track race since the Goodwill Games nine months ago. I'm a little disappointed with the time but with the wind and this being my first race, I'm just satisfied with the victory. With the wind like that, it's easy to let up so I'm glad I had some company to run with.

Todd Henecke, Cedar Rapids, Prairie: Winner HS Boys 3,200-Meter Run in 9:36.53

Curt Woodin (of Waverly-Shell Rock) and I have been running against each other since we were freshmen. We planned our strategy out ahead of time up to the last 100 meters. Then it's whoever has the best kick. There's no jealousy or anything.

I fell here last year and I came in near dead last. I was coming back for a little revenge this year. It felt good to win.

Jay Williams, Des Moines Roosevelt: Winner High School Boys Long Jump, 22-3

I knew on my last jump that I had to go for it all. I felt loose and relaxed coming down the runway. I felt it when I took off the board and I was watching the college long jump yesterday so I knew it was out there. I really wanted to go 23-7.

Last year I got scratched out of this event because I came in a little late and they had already taken my name off the list. This year I made sure that wasn't going to happen.

Allan Walz, Bondurant-Farrar: Winner HS Boys Discus, 184-7, DRAKE RELAYS RECORD

Last week I threw a 188 so I knew the record was a good possibility here. My dad prompts me every once in a while about getting the Drake Relays record. It just feels great, I'll tell you that. After my first throw, which went about 20 feet further than anyone elses, some of the pressure was off, but there was still a lot of pressure to get the record.

I never believed that when I was younger but now I'm sure that's the case. So I may take a breather and then come back when the time is right.

Fran tenBensel, Nebraska: 3rd runner on winning Women's 4x800 Meter Relay, University and College.

It was an exciting win for us. This is the first time that we have run together. I think this is the biggest crowd that I have ever run in front of. If you want to run a relay then this is the place to do it.

We knew that we were going to win this race all the way but we thought that it was going to be close but we ran so well.

Beatrice Utondu, Texas Southern: Winner of Women's Special Invitational 100 Meter Dash.

I felt good about the race although I slipped coming out of the blocks and I had to regain my balance.

Matt Hertig, Emporia State: Lead off runner on winning College Distance Medley Relay. Emporia State defended their title in this event.

This is our biggest meet and our goal is always to win at Drake. We are very team oriented and so we work together well.

One of my goals is to be a Drake Relays champion. I have been working hard. My technique is improving. You have to work to be one of the top guys in your field. Once you get to that level and cope with that, the sky's the limit.

Gwen Torrence, Nike South: Winner of Women's 400-Meter Dash, Special Invitational in :51.61.

The crowd here is great. They made me feel like Flo Jo. I think this is the best crowd in the United States. They make you feel so welcome. I will come here forever if they let me.

I thought the wind was going to blow me out but I have prepared for this.

It was good that she (Natasha Kaiser) was in front of me because I could see here all the way. When she didn't close in on me in the last 250 meters, I knew that I had her because nobody will run me down in the last 100 meters because I am so strong.

Rounding the corners are not my bag. This is my last 400 meter race. I think I will stick to 100 and 200 meters because I feel much more comfortable at those distances.

I saw Duval, the Iowa State runner, step on a barrier with about a lap to go and I knew he was tired. I had a lot left over so I knew I could finish strong.

I won the Penn Relays last year so I didn't want to go back that much. Frankly we came here because we sick of Penn a little bit. It's so much like cattle coming in and out and being held in the pen for half an hour before the race. Our coaches were not happy with the way athletes were treated. We wanted to try something new. I think Drake is a great meet. You don't know what you're missing until you try it.

<u>Michael Johnson, Nike International</u>: Winner 400-Meter Dash, Men's Spec. Invit. in 44.73

I just wanted to make a good showing today, see where I was with my training and then win the race. I feel I'm a lot further along than I was last year at this time.

It's good to come back to Drake. I ran here four years, mainly on relays. Now I'm on my own. It's really not as much fun now. I miss that team spirit.

My main focus now is to win the gold at the World Championships. I think it will take something in the 43.9 range. I have a lot of room for improvement in the 400. Any improvement in the 200 will be incremental. The 400 is something else. I'm glad I was able to run well here. It shows me that I'm about right where I want to be now.

Kevin Little, US West: 6th in 400-Meter Special Invit. in 46.77

I just never got into the race. At the 200 mark I tried to take off but I just couldn't stay with them. I was really tired at the end and that surprised me. I intended to use this race as training but I still wanted to run quicker. It's been a very busy weekend and I tried not to think about the race too much until today. This entire weekend has been a great experience and I want to thank Drake for honoring me as Grand Marshall. I'm very grateful.

Edith Nakiyingi, Iowa State: Winner Women's U-C 800-Meter Run in 2:06.17

I feel real happy to win all four in a row. I started out hard and nobody came with me so I slowed down. I wanted to run better than the record but I didn't have the competition. The wind didn't bother me at all.

Winning at the Drake Relays is always one of my major goals. Even four months away when I'm working out I'm thinking I have to push myself so I can do well at Drake. People are really into it here.

At this point I may just run the 800 at NCAAs. I haven't decided yet. I will run in Europe and then prepare for the World Championships.

Shaun Benefield, Mason City: Anchor on Winning High School Boys Sprint Medley Relay in 3:32.69.

The fact that this was my only race of the day helped a lot. I was well rested and ready to go. Really, winning this relay was the high point for me. I went out in a 400 pace because I knew it would take a lot to win. I felt it hurt at the 200 mark but I knew I could win. I made up my mind last night that I wanted to win.

Henry Brooks, Southwest Louisiana: Anchor on Winning University 4x400 Meter Relay in 3:03.51.

We wanted our shot at Baylor and today we got them. This is sweet revenge because we owed them. They beat us by .03 of a second at the Texas Relays and we came to Drake because they were coming here and because it is a bigger meet.

I am a come from behind runner and today fit that. In most races I make my move in the last 110 meters.

Devon Morris, Jamaica: Fourth place in the 400-Meter Dash, Men's Special Invitational in :46.19.

It (race) wasn't good for me. I felt tired after the first 200 meters. It could have been the seven hour ride up from St. Louis or something else. I don't know but the race just didn't feel good.

I respect Michael (Johnson) a lot. I guess you win some and you lose some. My relay team went to the Penn Relays but I wanted to come here because Drake is my place. The crowd gets into it and it is just a good place to run.

Raymond Pierre, Waco, Texas: Finished second in the 400-Meter Dash, Men's Special Invitational in :45.66.

Michael (Johnson) was coaching me the entire way. The race went very well since this is my first outdoor meet. Mike pushes me and I push him.

For me the rest of the season will be taken one step at a time. I want to make sure everything feels good and that I can work myself into decent condition.

Bill Payne, Baylor: Winner of University-College Pole Vault in 18-6 1/2, a new Drake Relays record.

I thought I could go over 19-0 today but I think I took too many jumps.

The crowd at the relays are great. They know and understand the pole vault and when you make a jump you hear from them. They really get into it.

I have been training pretty good. The yell I do at the start of each jump is something I have been doing since my freshman year. I think it gives me a little extra power.

John Nuttall, Iowa State: Winner of the University-College 1,500-Meter Run in 3:45.14.

We know we have a lot stronger team than last year and we are running a lot better as a result. Our team favors the distance side of track and we take pride in doing well especially here where we feel at home.

The local people give us a lot of encouragement and we field our best team because of that..

When you are running well, you get on a roll. We learn from one another as we go along in a season. The only thing wrong with today was the pace was too slow and that was disappointing. It took awhile to get going but when I found my groove things went as planned.

Rachel Lewis, Minnesota: Winner of Women's University and College Shot Put. She is a defending Drake Relays champion with a throw of 50-5 1/4.

I always get up for the relays. The meet is great but to tell you the truth today was not a very good meet for me. I am to the point where I am very tired and I need to take some time off.

I thought by this point in the season I would be throwing much better. I am looking forward to better throws and that will take preparation. Throwing the shot put and discus is physically demanding but a lot of it is mental as well.

Paul Ereng, Charlottesville, Va: Winner of 800-Meter Run, Men's Special Invitational in 1:46.82.

The race here is very special to me. I like running here because of the crowd and the surface is good.

I feel okay about the race today but for me right now it is a time of developing and getting ready for a heavier schedule of running. Every race is different, I take each one as they come.

Charles Lancon, Southwest Lousiana coach in the 400, 800 and 1600 meter relays).

We didn't decide to come to the Drake Relays until a month ago. This is a great meet and well organized. The officials do a great job. The kids are fired up about coming back here next year. Our 1600 meter relay barely got beat by Baylor at the Texas Relays (3:06.64 -- 3:06.67).

Our ultimate goal today was to qualify for the NCAA in that event. We were ranked ninth provisionally going into this weekend but we secured the NCAA qualifying today.

- **Shaun Benefield, Mason City, won his second straight boys high school 400-meter low hurdles being clocked in 53.27.
- **Lisa Stone, Baylor, won her second straight 10,000 meter run being clocked in 33:57.27.
- **Emporia State won its second straight CD Distance Medley Relay, being clocked in 9:59.50 (Matt Hertig, Desmond Pierre, Shawn Brewer, Alberto Lopez).
- **Karen Glerum, lowa State, won her second straight 1,500-meter run being clocked in 4:19.54.
