

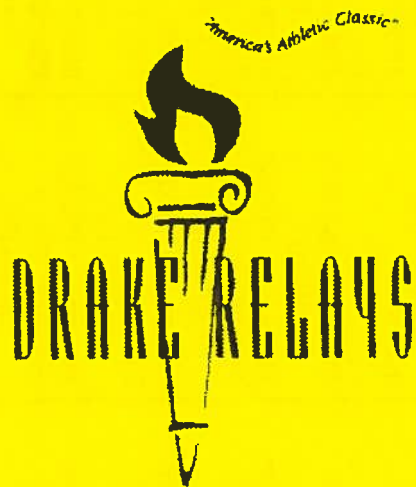

1996 Drake Relays Multi-Events - Thursday, April 25, 1996

Thursday morning weather: Cloudy, 56 degrees, dew point: 40 degrees, 55 percent humidity, Winds west at 14 mph, gusting to 25.

Thursday afternoon weather, 2 p.m.: Mostly sunny, 68 degrees, dewpoint: 27 degrees, 21 percent humidity, Winds west at 30 mph, gusting to 40.

Thursday afternoon weather, 4 p.m.: Partly sunny, 67 degrees, dewpoint: 26 degrees, 21 percent humidity, Winds west at 32 mph, gusting to 39 mph.

Heptathlon winner Rannveig Kvalvik, Freshman, Missouri, 5,160 points

"I was nervous. She (Central Michigan's Kary Tomaw, who was second with 5,047 points) had to beat me by about two-thirds of a second in the 800 to take the lead from me. I just wanted to go out hard in the beginning. I didn't know her PR (Toma's). I didn't want to go out too hard for a PR; I just wanted to make sure I didn't fall behind too much. Both my javelin and long jump were off from high school. I was happy with the 800, high jump and shot put."

Decathlon winner Kip Janvrin, Visa, Drake Relays record 8,198 points

"I didn't think it was going to happen today. Hopefully things will go right, and I'll make that team (the U.S. Olympic team). It wasn't raining, and it wasn't cold so the wind didn't bother me. It (the Drake Relays record) was something I had been thinking about, but it was just a lot of things working out. The weather was right, and the events just started clicking today. I never had a bad event.

"I am not peaking. There's a lot more left. I am going to do more speedwork and hopefully I'll be there in June. My goal was to come here to win — the points didn't matter. But Darwin (second-place finisher Vande Hoef) opened putting up those great numbers. I give Darwin a lot of credit for pushing over the top. It meant a lot to win Drake. This may be the last meet between Darwin and me."

Decathlon runner-up Darwin Vande Hoef, unattached, Ames, 7,867 points

"Today I got off to a bad start. In the hurdles I was hoping to go 14-flat or under, but ran about 14.3, and everything went in a little downward spiral from there. I dropped off just a little bit each event. I hit the first hurdle out of the blocks with my trail leg.

"Kip has told me I'm in (qualified for Olympic trials), but it would be nice to get that automatic mark of 8,000. I'm not competing until the trials, which are seven weeks away. I will work on the pole vault and fine-tune my throws.

"Kip has set a good standard. He's always willing to help. It's an honor to compete against him. I have competed here since I was a sophomore in high school. I have nothing but great times, performances and great memories. Competing here is one of my favorite things to do in the world. The decathlon is new for me, but I am really getting addicted."

NOTES: Janvrin breaks Bruce Jenner's old mark of 8,163, set in 1976. (Jenner's 8,250 were under old IAAF scoring tables and the mark totals 8,163 under the new tables) Jenner's decathlon record had been the oldest existing meet record. Janvrin is also getting inducted into the Drake Relays Hall of Fame Saturday.

1996 Drake Relays Multi-Events - Wednesday, April 24, 1996

Wednesday Weather: Mostly cloudy, 68 degrees, 24 degrees relative humidity, winds 14 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Heptathlon Leader Rannveig Kvalvik, Freshman, Missouri , first day leader, 3,078 points : "It feels better now than after my first heptathlon in Arizona. I'm getting in better shape. I'm not too happy with the 200. The wind was hard...but that's not a good excuse. The high jump was good, the shot was okay. I need to work on my speed. The second day is easier...only three more events. You have to think that you're not tired. The mental part is hard in the last event, the 800."

Decathlon Leader Darwin Vande Hoef, Unattached, Ames, first day leader, 4,275 points "That 7-1 high jump really helped. I haven't jumped out here for three years and usually it's been in bad weather. Kip's real good on the second day. I hope to have at least a 200 point lead. That should increase after the hurdles. Things have improved this year. I've definitely improved in the hurdles. I'm still struggling with the pole vault. He [Kip] is ahead of pace from last year. I hope I can hang in with him. I hope to break 8,000 points. Six weeks ago at Texas I scored 7,990."

Decathlon Kip Janvrin, Visa, second place, 4,110 points: "I'm very pleased with my first two events. In the long jump I had three jumps over 23 and I was very happy with that. The shot I'm very frustrated with. Under 45 is just not going to cut it. I'm not worried, I'm just disappointed. In the high jump I jumped my highest since 1991. I think he [Vande Hoef] is going to get 8,000 points. I'm glad I'm not going to be here in four years because that kid's going to be one of the best the U.S. has. He's improved and his throws will improve with age. He just needs a couple more years. I'm not competing against Darwin. I'm competing against myself. I hope he gets 8,000 points. I hope we both have a good day and we'll both be happy with each other. We're just here for the points."

NOTES: Vande Hoef also led the decathlon after the first day of competition last year. Both Vande Hoef and Janvrin are ahead of last year's pace. Vande Hoef's 4,275 points is well of ahead of his 4,073 he scored last year. Janvrin (4,110 points) had 3,985 points after the first day last year.

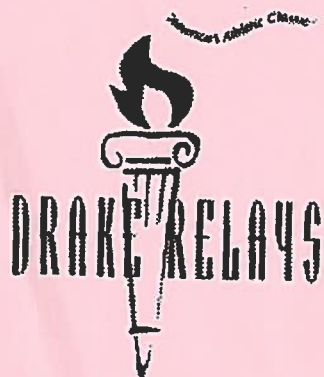
