Donostia-San Sebastian Donostia-San Sebastian, located in the north of the Iberian peninsula, on the Bay of Biscay, is the capital of one of the three provinces making up the Basque Country. Donostia-San Sebastian can be easily and quickly reached thanks to a modern motorway and road network, a railway system linked to the main Spanish and European cities and three nearby airports - Hondarribia (San Sebastián), Loiu (Bilbao) and Foronda (Vitoria) - which offer domestic and international flights.

San Sebastian (180,000 inhabitants) was built around a beautiful bay. It is an elegant, modern and harmonious city, where a high standard of life can be enjoyed. Its climate is characterised by a slight range in temperatures, with mild winters and cool summers.






FACILITIES

In San Sebastian we live for sport. The public multi-sports facilities plus the private ones make the sport activities possible almost in every corner of the city.

The most representative facility is the Anoeta Stadium, located in a sports complex where there is also a velodrome, a pelota court and swimming pools. The Stadium is where Real Sociedad, the local team that competes in the Spanish highest football category, usually plays.

The modern Stadium was inaugurated in 1993 and can hold 40,000 spectators. There and at the auxiliary track and field facilities will be held the 2005 events.
