IMPORTANT NOTICE CONCERNING AAU RE-REGITRATION: ALL CLUB MEMBERS TAKE NOTICE.

The AAU has devised a system of re-registration which will be more efficient than in the past. All club members will be registered as a group, with the clubs compiling the roster, and transmitting AAu dues and insurance for the member. Cards will then be issued to the clubs for distribution to the members. The AAU records will be held in a giant computer in Lincoln, Nebraska, and print-outs will be furnished to the clubs.

These innovations will result in :

- 1; Convenience to members, who will simply pay fees to their club and later get a card.
- 2; A pain in the neck for the club secretaries, who will have to bill for the money, register everyone, buy stamps for billing an transmittal of data, and distribute cards individually.
- 3; A new emphasis on membership in clubs, and a clear identification of the club to which a person belongs. Unattached persons will be listed separately in the AAU computer.

Having explored this proposition and deplored the work it means for us, your secretary sees no alternative but to comply, and get the job done. We are therefore requesting that you PROMPTLY SEND US THE FOLLOWING MONEY :

Make checks for the total amount to NCSTC. The Club will make your payment to the AAU. <u>It is imperative</u> that everyone who wishes 1975 club membership sends the check in by January 20,1975, so that the AAU fees can be calculated and paid early in the year. For the sake of your secretaries sanity and professional career, this must be done as a lump sum, not as individual actions. And we cannot register for you until you have sent us the money, credit being what it is these days. Remember, your AAU registration expires January 1 1975, and you will not be re-registered until we have completed this deal. If you are an early bird and have already registered with the AAU, send in your Club dues and indicate the regitration is completed. If you have already sent in 1975 NCSTC dues, forward the correct amount for the AAU registration to me (make check payable to NCSTC)

If anyone asks you to show your 1975 AAU card, show '74s, and indicate the new one is "in process". Your individual AAU number (last 5 digits) will remain the same, but the Association number will change from 384 to385. The NCSTC club number will stay the same at #197, but this probably doesn't matter to you.

A final plea to attend to this matter at your earliest convenience, hopefully by return mail. I cannot afford to remind you individually, nor to submit the AAU computer forms in batches; rather it must be done as a concerted effort to be tolerable. I count on your help.
